Are you a Challenge caller?

If you call for open dances where various levels of ability are present — then you call Challenge. Each time a caller has dancers of different abilities on the floor, and, like most callers, you want to keep everyone happy, it is definitely a challenge.

Years back, a person could pick up a few records, learn a few calls and become a Caller. Today this would be a very hazardous way of making a success in the Calling field, with perhaps an exception in rural areas where there are no other callers.

It is advisable for all callers to occasionally attend a callers' school or callers' clinic to learn something new or to refurbish what he has forgotten. Attending a callers' school or clinic with an open mind can be a very rewarding experience. It gives you an opportunity to meet callers from all parts of the state and openly discuss how we can resolve our problems in square dancing.

If you have not filled out your questionnaire for John Saunders, please do so and mail it to him immediately. Your input is very important in making the Florida Callers Association Fall Clinic a success.

I ask all area Association officers to please encourage all callers in your area to attend the Fall Clinic.

Caller's Corner

THE PLUS PROGRAM

Last month in our mainstream section we explored the basic *Zoom*. If you have taken the time to read and use the various applications please do then proceed into the use of *Zoom once & 1/2 . . . or 1/2 Zoom*. In order to accept how a one half zoom action takes place, let's look at the parts of the zoom. The trailing dancer in a zoom steps ahead into the position of the lead dancer so a 1/2 zoom has the trailing dancer simply step 1/2 of the way forward. The lead dancer in a zoom does three parts...first he/she starts the loop to move toward replacing the trailing dancer, call the loop part one, next they move ahead to the position of the trailing dancer and third they loop about face to end in the footprints of the trailing dancer. Now to have the lead dancer do 1/2 a zoom has them do the first loop about face and move forward 1/2 way.

Ending Formation when using 1/2 Zoom

1. From a double pass thru formation a 1/2 zoom ends in an inverted line, centers facing in and the ends facing out.
2. From a completed double pass thru formation a 1/2 zoom ends in an inverted line with the ends facing in and the centers facing out.
3. From right handed box circulate formation you end in left handed ocean wave.
4. From a left handed box circulate formation you will end in right handed wave.

The use of 1/2 zoom by the ends of waves or two faced lines or by the center box in a column will provide some interesting choreography at all levels. Many of the plus and mainstream dancers may find this action a bit challenging so be cautious and *know your dancers*. **Judgement:** Once the 1/2 zoom is taught the *zoom once & 1/2* has a little more motion as you do a full zoom followed by a 1/2 zoom.

Heads Star Thru...1/2 Zoom....

Ends Trade..Touch 1/4..Boys Run....Left Alle..Zero box..

Heads Slide Thru..Curlique...1/2 Zoom...(ends in left hand wave)

Trade the Wave..Recycle...Lead to the Right...Left Alle...

Zero Line: Touch 1/4..Single File Circulate...Center Four..1/2 Zoom..

Centers Trade the Wave...End Boys Run (this action ends in a 1/4 tag formation)

Extend...Girls Trade..Recycle..Pass to the Center..Square Thru 3/4.. Left Alle..zero box

This one is a bit challenging:

Zero Box: Right & Left Thru..Veer Left..Couples Circulate..Boys 1/2 Zoom..

Girls Single Hinge and the Center Girls Trade..All the Centers Run..

MAKING USE OF "PASS THE OCEAN"

There are so many different things you can do with this basic, and so many different ways to get into and out of it, this would be a good place to have a look at things we can do. For a starter let's look at just how easy it is to Zero the figure out. For instance,

One and Three will Pass the Ocean Recycle - and Sweep a Quarter -

At that point they are right back in the Static position they started from. Of course we can

Heads Right and Circle to a Line Pass the Ocean - Recycle - Sweep 1/4

They are back where they were when they led right and circled to a line. No problem so far. Let's go back and take a look at what happens if we do not *Sweep a Quarter* -

Heads Right & Circle to a Line - Pass the Ocean - Recycle Swing Thru - Girls Trade - Boys Trade Turn Thru, Left Allemande.

Taking a quick look at a few Equivalents now;

Heads Pass the Ocean - Recycle - and Star Thru -

The above is Equivalent to "Two Ladies Chain". Of course this means that we could "repeat" the same thing and *Zero* it back to our Static position again. This also applies to *Lines of Four*. We can add to the above very easily and we can still keep it simple for ourselves.

Heads Square Thru - Pass the Ocean

**Recycle -
Flutter Wheel -
Square Thru
* 3/4's Around
Left Allemande...**

Or, at the *
**Star Thru - Dive Thru - Square Thru
3/4's Around, Left Allemande...**

Another simple Equivalent goes like this, and the same thing works from Lines of Four,

One and Three Slide Thru - Pass the Ocean - Recycle -

The above is another place where it is Equivalent to a "Two Ladies Chain". Nothing to it.

Still using that last figure, simply add a "Sweep a Quarter" and it would then be Equivalent to a "Star Thru". In other words, using the above, *One and Three Slide Thru - Pass the Ocean - Recycle - Sweep 1/4 - Square Thru 3/4's Around, Allemande Left with your left hand.* It's easy.

Take something like this and start playing around with it and see just how many different things you can do with it, and see how simple they are to put together, and take apart.

When you take about a half dozen of this type of basic and break them down and see what you can do with them, how easy it is to take them apart and then put them back together, knowing what they are equivalent to, and how easy it is to Zero them out, — with those half dozen basics you can put out

FIRST REPORT OF 1983 DANCER SURVEY ANNOUNCED

The 5,481 forms received in LEGACY's third square dancer survey have been compiled and the results reviewed by its Trustees. All states, Canada and several other nations participated in the survey. Thanks to a computer, a good program and a good operator, the 208,000 data points and 127 pages of comments were reduced in three mini-floppy discs.

Comments were printed in book form for a detailed review by three Trustees who presented their summaries at LEGACY VI in St. Louis last May. It was obvious to all that a great deal of thought, some good ideas and a mountain of love for the activity were evident. Comments ranged from one very succinct sentence to several pages. Everyone who added comments to their survey form can rest assured they have been heard.

The average survey respondent danced between 4 and 5 times per month and have about 5 years' experience. The largest group by frequency danced 4 times a month and the largest group by experience had been dancing 3 years. In LEGACY's 1981 survey, the largest group of dancers by experience had been dancing 2 years and the average had been dancing 4 years. This fact suggests that new dancer retention was less than average between 1981 and 1983.

About two-thirds of all dancers had been club officers. One-fourth had attended a square dance leadership panel or seminar and two-thirds of those found the information useful.

Respondents were asked what methods of teaching and/or emphasizing etiquette were most effective. 68% voted "caller in class" with "by example" and "experienced dancer in class" each receiving a little less than half as many checks. Dancers apparently deem "written material" ineffective since it was checked on only 6% of the forms.

Dance "mixers" were appreciated more by

the less experienced and less frequent dancers. Higher frequency dancers rated "clothes" more positively. Dancers with 4 to 5 years' experience had the lowest opinion of club leadership. The poorest overall attitude was scored by 6 to 7 year dancers.

Dancers were asked, "Of those you know who've dropped out of square dancing, what do you feel were the most significant reasons for their disappearance from our activity?" The 5,481 respondents checked their forms as follows:

- 38% Felt pressure - towards higher dance levels
- 28% Felt rushed - inadequate learning time
- 21% Social - not accepted by group
- 13% Caller - inadequate in some way
- 11% Club - functions or responsibilities
- 11% Were bored - not enough variety
- 8% Styling - rough or non-standard moves
- 34% Other

A total of 2,195 "other" reasons were given. They broke down into three broad groups: personal (1,250), club related (408), and other dance related reasons, such as "no partners for singles" (82).

The attitude portion of the survey was designed to define changes in dancers' values regarding 14 different aspects of the square dancing activity. It has a +5 to -5 scale and has been used in the same format for all three ('80, '81, '83) LEGACY dancer surveys. Dancers rated the overall activity plus 2.4 in the first survey, plus 2.0 in the second and plus 2.1 in the third. Averages for 12 of the 14 separate aspects followed the same profile or had no significant trend. The two that did not conform were "new acquaintances" and "pleasure of dancing". Dancers have collectively rated these

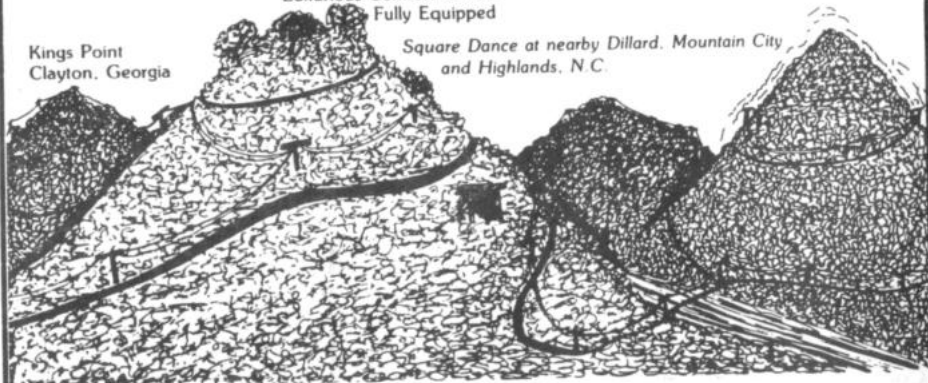

lower in each of the three successive surveys. "Pleasure of dancing" has always been the top scoring aspect, starting with a plus 4.5 in the first, plus 4.4 in the second and plus 4.3 in the third. However, the steady decline as scored by more than 10,000 dancers over 4 years should be a cause for concern by dancers and callers alike.

It is impossible to objectively summarize 127 pages of comments and two hundred thousand data points from dancers with such a wide variety of goals. It would seem, however, that most were saying, "Keep the fun and pleasure in dancing, teach them social as well as dancing skills, and reduce pressures wherever you can."

Copies of the comments and data summaries (by state and overall) are available from LEGACY's Executive Secretaries, Don and Vera Chestnut, 2149 Dahlk Circle, Verona, Wisconsin 53593. Some states did not have enough forms submitted to provide adequate data.

Another survey is planned for distribution in

late 1984.

LEGACY is the international communications resource and leadership center of the square dance activity.

Legacy Trustees attend their conventions at their own expense for the purpose of exchanging ideas. This year's theme was *Cooperation* with the use of FLAGS as the acronym to formulate topics. Subjects covered were Friendship, Leadership, Attitude, Giving and Styling.

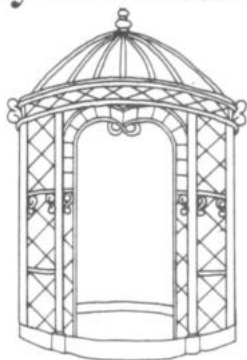

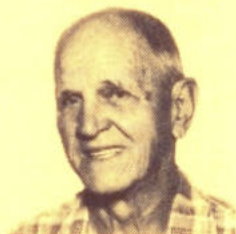

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

(Continued from Page 20)

a fair evening of calling, and you can keep them listening to you all the time. When you get used to them and can relax and just take off on your own, knowing full well that you can maneuver them around to where you want them, then Square Dance Calling becomes fun.

Keeping that in mind, try this,

**Heads Right, Circle to a Line
Pass the Ocean - Recycle
Slide Thru (IN sequence)
Pass Thru and Bend the Line -
Pass the Ocean - Recycle - Slide Thru
(OUT of Sequence, with OPPOSITE)**

Right here we could go back to that change that I use so often. When we have the opposite lady for a partner, IN Sequence, we can *Dive Thru, Pass Thru, Star Thru, Cross-Trail Thru, Left Allemande*. So from the above, we would have the dancers *Star Thru*, putting them back IN Sequence, then follow up with the *Dive thru, Pass Thru, Star Thru* and *Cross-Trail Thru*, etc.

One of my favorite ways to set up for "Ping Pong Circulate" is something like this,

**One and Three - Pass the Ocean
Ping Pong Circulate - Swing Thru -
Swing Thru once more - then -
Ping Pong Circulate - then -
Swing Thru - don't stop -
Spin the Top, Cross-Trail Thru
Allemande Left with your left hand.**

There are many, many different ways that you can use "Pass the Ocean". Let's say that we want to use it for nothing but changing the ladies around like this, for instance,

**Heads Right, Circle to a Line
Right & Left Thru - Flutter Wheel
Pass the Ocean - Recycle
Sweep a Quarter - Pass Thru -
Bend the Line - Right & Left Thru
Flutterwheel - Pass the Ocean
Recycle and - Sweep a Quarter -**

At this point each gent is with his opposite lady and the important thing is, each gent is IN Sequence right where he started in those lines of four. There are so many different things that you can use at this point, I'll just leave it to your own imagination.

Take care now.

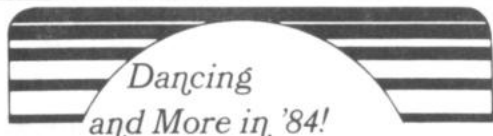

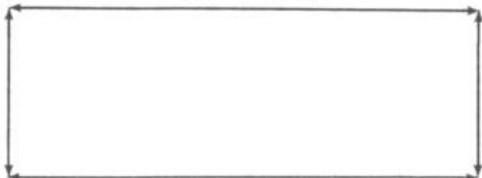

CALLERLAB RULES ON AFFILIATION AND ACCREDITATION EASED

Several years ago, *Callerlab* approved a method of Caller Association Affiliation to encourage closer ties between callers' associations and *Callerlab*. The affiliation does not provide individual membership but does enable affiliated organizations to receive copies of publications and to keep abreast of *Callerlab* activities. Associations seeking Affiliate status must make application and pay a fee of \$25.00. The annual renewal fee is \$15.00. Affiliated organizations must also abide by the *Callerlab* Code of Ethics.

It is no longer required that the organization have at least one member who is a *Callerlab* member in attendance at the *Callerlab* convention each year. Bonafide callers' associations may be granted affiliate status whether or not they have a *Callerlab* member and may continue this affiliation for a period of up to 3 years, at which time at least one of their members must become a member and attend the annual convention.

Affiliate organization renewal is contingent on at least one *Callerlab* member attending a convention on the same basis as required for full members; i.e., once in 3 years for North American residents and once in 6 years for non-North Americans.

Aspects of caller accreditation also were modified at the *Callerlab* convention. The period of time for re-accreditation was changed from 5 to 6 years. The number of signatures required to revalidate experience was changed from 3 to 1. Procedures also were established to accommodate callers in isolated or rural areas who have difficulty in meeting accreditation requirements. Each case will be handled on its own merits, and callers who have a problem may request a waiver from the Accreditation Committee.

Applications for affiliation and requests for waivers on accreditation should be directed to *Callerlab*, Box 679, Pocono Pines, PA 18350.
