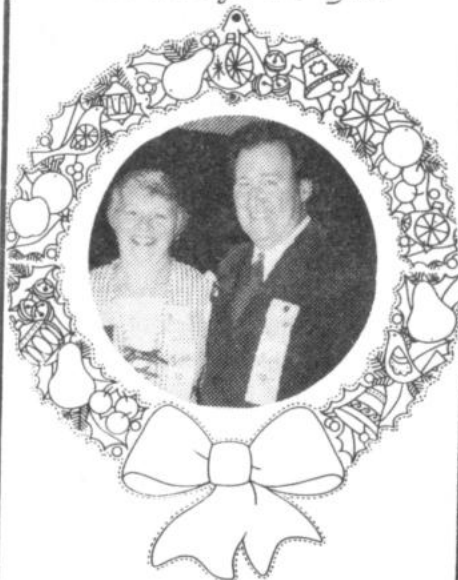

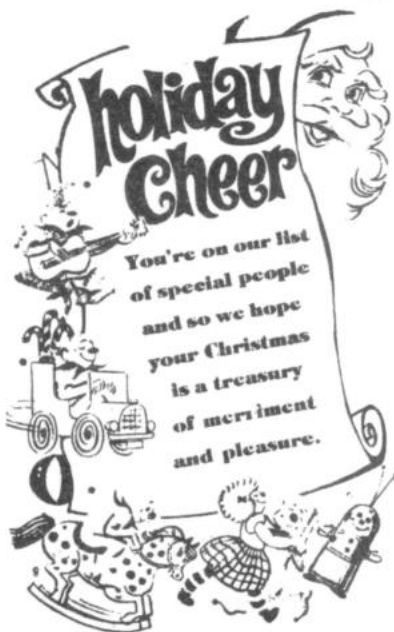

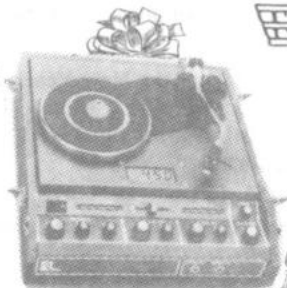

JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



## MAINSTREAM QUARTERLY SELECTION RIPPLE....Curley Custer

Ripple is a simple call that has the ability to change your formation rather quickly and can be used easily by Mainstream dancers, and, in its challenging form, with plus and advanced dancers.

**Ripple** starts from any facing dancer formation.

The **ACTION**: Dancers join both hands with the facing dancer and circle left half way, then pass thru ending back to back . . . The addition of the command **Right, Left, In** or **Out** after the ripple will change the dancers' facing direction and result in formation changes . . .

### FORMATION AWARENESS USING RIPPLE:

FROM AN EIGHT CHAIN THRU FORMATION:

1. Ripple . . . Ends in a Trade By Formation.
2. Ripple Right . . . Ends in parallel right handed waves.
3. Ripple Left . . . Ends in parallel left handed waves..requires a little "dancer adjustment" to form the left handed waves...(I call this a Fudge Ripple)
4. Ripple In . . . Ends in lines facing in.
5. Ripple Out . . . Ends in lines facing out.

FROM LINES OF FOUR FACING IN:

1. Ripple . . . Ends in lines facing out.
2. Ripple Right . . . Ends in right handed columns.
3. Ripple Left . . . Ends in Left handed columns.
4. Ripple In . . . Ends in a starting double pass thru formation.
5. Ripple Out . . . Ends in a completed double pass thru formation.

The creativity in the call comes when you have a variety of formations in which two boys are facing two girls, or when facing couples have one couple half-sashayed and call Ripple . . . **Boys face in Girls out** or Ripple..Boys face right girls in, etc....

While I'm sure you see that all a Ripple is, is a two-handed turn thru, the facing changes and the many possible formation changes make Ripple a very interesting simple call... NOTE: If your dancers are poor at touching adjacent dancers' hands after all calls, they may find Ripple and its formation changes more challenging than you thought.

Zero Box: Ripple...Centers Ripple..Centers In...

Cast Off 3/4...Box the Gnat...Slide Thru...Left Alle...(zero box)

Zero Box: Ripple Right...Scoot Back...Walk & Dodge...

Partner Trade...Right & Left Thru...Pass the Ocean...Recycle...Left Alle...

Zero Line: Ripple Right...Single File Circulate...Girls Run...Star Thru...Calif. Twirl...Slide Thru...Left Alle...(zero box)

# TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

*Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills*

## WHEEL & DEAL

The reason you find callers using the "Wheel & Deal" figures so much is the fact that you can get your dancers into so many different figures from this set-up. This means that it actually is a set-up formation, getting set up for something that follows. Let's look at a few of them,

**Heads Right and Circle to a Line  
Now Pass Thru and Wheel & Deal  
Center Four will Swing Thru -  
Then Turn Thru, Left Allemande...**

Set it up like this,

**Heads Right and Circle to a Line  
Then Pass Thru and Wheel & Deal  
Center 4 will - Star Thru -  
Flutter Wheel - Sweep a Quarter -  
Center 4 will - Swing Thru -  
Then Turn Thru, Left Allemande...**

As you can see, the Star Thru, Flutter Wheel and Sweep a Quarter, brought them right back where they were when they first did the "Wheel & Deal". This should give you some ideas for adding more. Like this,

**Heads Right and Circle to a Line  
Then Pass Thru and Wheel & Deal  
Center 4 go Right & Left Thru  
Turn on around and - Star Thru -  
Flutter Wheel - Sweep a Quarter -  
Swing Thru - Girls Trade, Boys Trade,  
Turn Thru, Left Allemande...**

Notice in the above that we added a "Right & Left Thru" for the Center couples. Also, you will notice that we cancelled that out by adding a "Girls Trade, Boys Trade". Remember, we have determined before that

a "Girls Trade, Boys Trade" cancels out a "Right & Left Thru".

This is a good thing to remember. If you have your dancers set up to "Swing Thru and Turn Thru to a Left Allemande, you can add a "Right & Left Thru" before you do the - Swing Thru. Then add "Girls Trade, Boys Trade" and you are right back where you started.

We can set it up differently to start off and have them ready to "Square Thru 3/4's around to a Left Allemande. Like so,

**Side Ladies Chain Across the floor  
Heads to the Right and Circle Four  
Head Gents Break - Forward and  
Back  
Then Pass Thru and - Wheel & Deal -  
Center Four will Square Thru 3/4's -  
Look for the Corner, Left Allemande.**

You can set it up after they have done the Pass Thru and Wheel & Deal - something like so,

**Heads Right and Circle to a Line  
Then Pass Thru and - Wheel & Deal  
Center Four go - Right & Left Thru  
Flutter Wheel - Square Thru 3/4's -  
Allemande Left with your left hand...**

Now think of all the different things you can get your dancers into by setting them up in that "Wheel & Deal" situation. We will start off again putting them into this position,

**Heads Right and Circle to a Line**

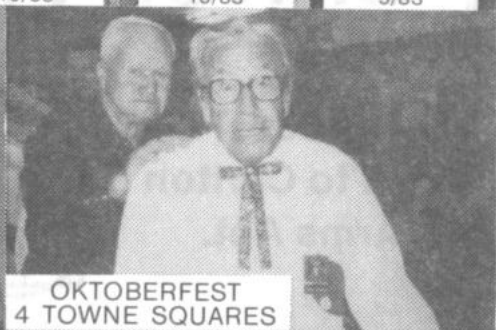

Mix to a Diamond is an easily made call using existing basics and uses an advanced concept, MIX, so why not call it directionally at PLUS and give it a name at Advanced. YOU are the final judge along with the DANCERS. If you feel as I do, let the CALLERLAB office know your feelings in petition form from your dancers. IT WORKS....THEY LISTEN...

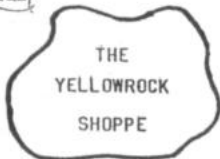

**Then Pass Thru and Wheel & Deal -**

Now we can

**Double Pass Thru**

**Clover Leaf out and come back in -**

(at this point they are with opposites)

**Double Pass Thru and do it again -**

**Clover Leaf out and come back in**

(now they are with partners again)

Now we can

**Double Pass Thru**

**First couple go Left, next go Right**

(Now we have them in lines of four, with Partners. *IN* Sequence).

**Star Thru and - Square Thru 3/4's -**

**Find old Corner, Left Allemande...**

These are just a few of the things that we can move the dancers into from "Wheel & Deal".

We use it like this too,

**Heads Right and Circle to a Line**

**Then Pass Thru and Wheel & Deal**

**Double Pass Thru**

**Centers In and - Cast Off 3/4's -**

(Now we have lady with lady, gent with gent)

**Pass Thru again and - Wheel & Deal**

(Ladies in the lead at this point)

**Double Pass Thru**

**Centers In and - Cast Off 3/4's -**

(now we have a gent with lady on his right, and a gent with the lady on his left)

**Pass Thru now and - Wheel & Deal -**

**\* Double Pass Thru**

**Centers In and Cast Off 3/4's round**

(they have partners back and they are *In* Sequence at this point).

And of course we use this same set-up to get them into a Track II position.

I have fun with the dancers, laughing *WITH* them, when I am using the above set-up and they do just that last part of it. Take it from those last two lines in the above where it is,

**\* Double Pass Thru**

**Centers In and - Cast Off 3/4's -**

**Allemande Left with your left hand -**

At this point just watch them turn every way but right - Two Gents have corners across from them but the other two gents have them right beside them and they don't know it and start looking every place except the right place. You can't pull this on them very often but it works once in awhile.

## The International Association of Round Dance Teachers

Round dance teachers from 27 states, including Gladys Ionin of Alaska, and one from Canada, attended the 7th Annual ROUNDALAB convention in Indianapolis, Indiana October 23-25. Attending as official representatives of CALLERLAB were Chairman Bob & Roberta Van Antwerp and Assistant Executive Secretary Herb & Erna Egender. Also recognized were ROUNDALAB members George & Joyce Kammerer, First Vice Presidents of the Universal Round Dance Council, and Doc & Peg Tirrell, Chairmen of LEGACY.

Early ROUNDALAB registrants were welcomed at a pre-convention round dance party Saturday evening at which the Indiana Round Dance Council read a proclamation from Governor Robert Orr declaring October 23-29, 1983 as *Round Dance Week* in the State of Indiana.

All who attended the convention had an opportunity to share their expertise and talents as the attendees made further progress in defining the phases and terminology used in round dancing.

The Educational Committee provided two very informative sessions: Pete Hickman discussed a philosophy on the way we learn and its application to the round dance activity. Betty & Clancy Mueller and Irv Easterday and Madeline Lovelace demonstrated and answered questions regarding the definitions in phases 2 and 4 of round dancing.

The 1983-84 Classic List was adopted, additions were made to the ROUNDALAB Code of Ethics, more round dance terminology, cue words and abbreviations were approved. Committees to

develop a dancer survey, accreditation, re-examine the dance level rating system and explore video taping as a teaching tool were formed.

At the Sunday evening banquet, Indianapolis Mayor William Hudnut welcomed all on behalf of his city and declared the week of October 23-29 as Round Dance Week in Indianapolis. At the Monday evening banquet, certificates were presented to those attendees who had reached their 10th and 15th year of teaching in 1983. "Maestro" trophies were awarded to 26 attendees who have been teaching 25 or more years, including Bob & Ted Meyers (NM) who have been teaching 45 years.
