CALLER'S 25th ANNIVERSARY

1983 marks the 25th year for Singin' Sam Mitchell as a Caller. A full time caller, he was a Traveling Caller for over 20 years and has called in every state but Alaska.

He was born in Kansas City, Missouri, but lived most of his life in Kansas City, Kansas. Sam was a U. S. Marine in WW II. After the war, he met Betty at the Pla-Mor Ballroom in the big band days. Betty was Recruiting Chairman at that time for "The Skyliners", a club for tall people, and she recruited Sam. After the first time he danced with Betty, Sam told a friend that Betty was the girl he was going to marry, and sure enough, they were married the following spring. They rode the El Capitan train to Los Angeles on their honeymoon to attend the First National Convention for tall people. They now have 3 grown children and 7 grandchildren.

Sam and Betty got into Square Dancing through Betty's parents, who square danced before the changeover to Western Style. When they moved to Tucson, Arizona in 1957 to get away from the cold winters, they got into a class the second week they were there. A month later they were club officers and four months later he called his first tip. In less than a year he was calling and teaching beginner classes and has not stopped since.

The exposure in Tucson was good and the winter guests went home and got their home clubs to write and hire Sam to call for them. Soon he was traveling more than he was home, so the family moved to Lansing, Michigan. They were back to the cold winters again, but Lansing was a good central location and had a good School for the Blind for one of the girls.

Sam called for 7 clubs in Michigan, Indiana and Illinois and still traveled 80,000 to 90,000 miles a year. At the end of 1973, he completed driving one million miles for Square Dancing - Accident Free.

In April, 1972 he suffered a severe heart attack. He is fully recovered now, but at that time he decided there was more to life than driving his car to dances - so Sam and Betty moved to Holiday, Florida in 1973 so he could spend his days off fishing and golfing.

He now calls for three weekly clubs, three once-a-month clubs, and two seasonal workshops weekly, plus festivals, weekends and Resort Weeks, but spends most of his time in Florida. He recently resigned from the staff of Kirkwood Lodge (Missouri) after 17 years. He was a Washington, D.C. Staff Caller for 10 years. He has been on the staff at Cherry Ridge Campgrounds for 14 years; Andy's Trout Farm 5 years; Beryl Main's Lighted Lantern for 3 years.

He has escorted six groups to Hawaii, two groups to the Caribbean, one to Spain, and conducts Callers' classes, colleges and clinics all over the country.

Sam has recorded on 8 different labels. His first record was "Little Lulu" on Dash records, and since then he has cut 37 records, including 5 L.P.s. The song, "I've Been Everywhere" should be his theme song. He is branded as a singer, but his love is patter.

With this impressive list of credits, Florida is privileged to have Sam Mitchell as one of its outstanding callers.

There are many articles on Pat Squares. Here's another view.

I would like to take you to your first night of class when the caller said "Men, take your partner, put her on your right and form a circle." At that very moment there was a feeling of excitement and fear. The excitement was this new adventure called Square Dancing. The fear - "Will I be able to learn?" Just maybe the friend that invited you was there or a member of the club with a smile and a friendly "hello" stood by you for your first tip. What a good feeling to know you had their support.

As you caller taught everyone to DoSaDo, Swing and Promenade, things went well. As time went on, some of the most important things were taught:

- Do not walk out of a square.
- Dance with as many other couples as possible.
- Don't always be a Head Couple.
- Do not attend a dance where the calls used are above the class level you have completed.
- And above all, follow the ten commandments Square Dancing.

It is also very important to attend club and special dances as regularly as possible so one may practice what they have been taught in class and pick up calls they have not yet heard. There are dancers who will attend only their club dance twice a month, some once a week, and some will start their progression through the next level and will dance three or four times a week so they may become more aware of the various positions.

There are some dancers who will not be able to keep up with their friends and will drop back to the next lower level.

Here we must take a good look at ourselves. It is human nature to want to be successful when we dance. When at a dance, we will look for our friends we have spent three and four nights a week with. Is this good or bad? Making a pat square or just dancing with your friends? Using good judgment on your part as a dancer will be to share your good dancing ability with as many people as possible.

At every big dance, make it your number one goal to meet a new friend so that Square Dancing will grow with fun and fellowship.

FLORIDA'S COSTUME FOR THE NATIONAL CONVENTION

Our grateful thanks to everyone for their suggestions and ideas for the Florida state outfit to be worn at the National Convention in Louisville, Ky., June 23, 24, 25, 1983.

With that input, and information on what other states have done in the past, we came up with the following guidelines for our decision:

1. Simplicity in design, easily made
2. A color that always stands out, in a crowd
3. The color easiest to match - statewide
4. The color and design that would look best - in the majority

Our colors will be bright red and pure white.

For the men:

White pants, red shirt (the color closest to matching their partner's dress) white tie (type - optional), white shoes and towel.

For the Women:

The dress, the brightest, clearest red you can find, with white trim. Make the dress with your preference in style of bodice, neckline, sleeves (short preferred) and skirt.

In the trim is where we will try to be as closely matched as possible. *Trim for the neckline:* Use 1 inch width lace, slightly gathered. Place on neckline, ¼ inch from neck edge. Use the same type 1 inch lace on sleeve cuff or edge. *For the skirt:* Make a 4 inch finished ruffle of white material, lace or embroidered lace. Gather ruffle ¾ inch from edge of material. Starting at the center front, place ruffle completely around the bottom of the skirt, and when you reach the center front of the skirt again, start curving your ruffle up, to the left side

seam at the waist.

If you are not sure of the correct placement of the ruffle, check a square dance dress pattern with this type of ruffle.

On the right side of the skirt we will all be placing a design of the state of Florida. We wish all of the states to be identical, so we will make them for you. Each completed state will have a special mark on them, depicting the location of the city in which you live. We will also be making miniature states for the men's right shirt pocket.

To receive your "state" and exact placement position, send \$1.50 for each large state and 50¢ for each small state, with your name and address to:

You can expect delivery within two to four weeks. (It would be helpful, if you do not live in a major city, to draw a sketch of Florida and mark where you are located).

Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



THE PLUS PROGRAM:

I hear from many callers that while the plus program is growing in popularity a few of the plus calls are often poorly danced by the average plus dancer....The calls are crossfire, 3/4 tag the line and Grand swing thru.....I'm really not sure if these calls get lost in the shuffle by many callers but if you will work with your dancers on these basics they will be able to do them as well as they do a load the boat... The most difficult of the three is the crossfire which does require some dancer reaction and good timing but there are many ways to use crossfire that its worth the effort on your part and of course the dancers...

I will keep the crossfire action to a standard two faced line with boys as ends and girls as centers...Remember the action has the ends do a cross fold as the centers trade & extend forming a box circulate set up for the foursome which can result in parallel ocean waves, columns or one single split circulate box.....In past issues this year I have explored the use of the definition of crossfire but now lets just get the dancers who don't use the figure to accept and enjoy its action.....

ZERO BOX..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..COUPLES CIRCULATE..
CROSSFIRE..ALL 8 CIRCULATE..BOYS RUN..
SWING THRU..TURN THRU ..LEFT ALLE...

ZERO BOX..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..VEER LEFT..
FERRIS WHEEL..CENTERS RIGHT & LEFT THRU & VEER LEFT..
CENTERS CROSSFIRE..WALK & DODGE..LEFT ALLE...

ZERO BOX..RIGHT & LEFT THRU..VEER LEFT..COUPLES HINGE..
CROSSFIRE..(ends in a parallel wave formation)
SCOOT BACK..BOYS RUN..STAR THRU..
PASS TO THE CENTER..SQUARE THRU 3/4..LEFT ALLE...

Now if your dancers will work with the three basic formations used in the above examples they will find that YOU will be able to mix crossfire into many smooth dancing combinations.

3/4 TAG THE LINE IS also a useful plus basic that often gets overlooked by callers and as a result the dancers struggle when it is called....When teaching the 3/4 tag I start with standard two faced lines and review a 1/2 tag and then call an extend setting up the 3/4 tag ending formation....I also tell the dancers that the ends of the line will end up forming a right handed wave in the center as the leaders or centers of the line will end facing directly ahead exactly as if they had done a normal tag the line..... Be sure that you have boys and girls playing the ends of the linesAfter the two faced line is comfortable I expand to lines facing out....Rules and ending formations remain the same.

ZERO BOX..SWING THRU..BOYS RUN..3/4 TAG THE LINE..
BOYS SWING THRU..GIRLS PARTNER TRADE..
BOYS EXTEND..BOYS RUN..LEFT ALLE...

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills

TWO CHAIN FIGURES

Editor's note: As Les Gotcher continues to explore the "Two Ladies Chain", he presents some interesting and challenging variations of the Basic square dance movements.


ISLAND CHAIN

This one was accidentally worked out by a group of dancers way back in 1952 while trying to work out the Tea Cup Chain. This group was in Long Island, New York - they called themselves "The Island Squares", so when they came up with something new they called it "Island Chain". The call is something like so:

Head two ladies Wheel Chain
Side ladies right and back again
Side two ladies Wheel Chain
Head ladies right and back again
Head two ladies Wheel Chain
Side ladies right and back again
Side two ladies Wheel Chain
Head ladies right and back again

As you can see, there is nothing difficult about the call. Just "Heads wheel, sides right, the Sides Wheel, Heads Right" and that's all there is to it, except, of course, the dancers will have to know what to do when they get there, etc. I will give you a complete breakdown on it:

INSTRUCTIONS: For Island Chain, the first thing you will have to teach the dancers is "Wheel Chain". We used it back in those days and it was simply a "Two Ladies Chain" only the ladies would catch forearms, right of course, and turn *once and a half* instead of the usual *half turn* that we use when we do a Ladies Chain. So while the Head Ladies are doing the "Wheel Chain"



to be ready to come out with the opposite man (same as Two Ladies Chain), the Side Ladies go to the Head Man on their Right, he turns her, either Courtesy or forearm, whichever you prefer, *Now* he sends her right back to the man she came from. In other words, while head ladies are doing the first wheel chain, the side ladies go to the head man on their right, he turns her and sends her back to her partner with the left hand.

The side men turn their ladies and now they put them into the center where they will do the "Wheel Chain", the head ladies will go to the man on the right of where they are at this time. The side men will turn the head ladies and send them back to the man who sent them to him (head ladies opposite).

Again the head ladies will go into the center and do a "Wheel Chain" again, side ladies going to the Head Man on their Right. He turns them and sends back to the man who sent them to him (their opposite).

He now turns them and puts them into the center where they will do a "Wheel Chain" which will take them back to their original partner. And now they are all back with their original partners, ready for whatever you want to hit them with - a Circle Left, or a Tea Cup Chain, or whatever.

After your dancers get these chains all worked up, you can move from one right into the other and make it very effective. They'll love it.

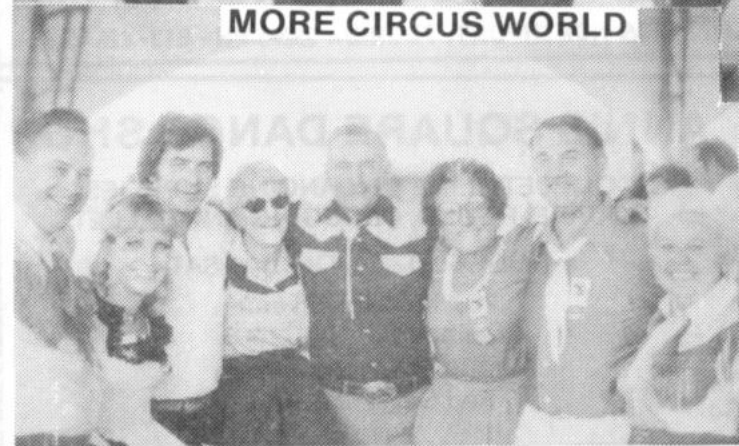

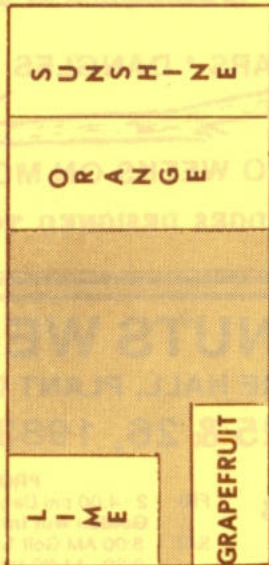

EVERYBODY CHAIN

The ladies love this one because it is one of the very few movements where the men do more than the ladies do. After they learn how to do this one with ease, you can throw it in following a Tea Cup Chain, or an Island Chain, or almost anywhere you care to throw it in. One thing I am going to point out to you - when going into "Chain" figures; at the beginning, I always start them off so that they will be doing a "Courtesy turn" and this leaves the ladies with the right hand free, ready for whichever star or chain figure you are going to use. For instance, I usually call for the ladies to *Four Ladies Chain, a Grand Chain Four*, then I follow that with *Now chain 'em back across the floor and get all set for the Tea Cup Chain*, or the *Island Chain*, or *Everybody Chain*, etc., like this:

Four ladies chain, a Grand Chain four
Turn the girls, let's dance some more
Now chain 'em back across the ring
And get all set for - Everybody Chain
Four ladies chain straight across
Head two men Chain to the Right
Turn those girls and send 'em back
Same two men Chain to the Right
Turn this girl and send her back
Same two men Chain to the Right
Turn this girl and send her back
Same two men Chain to the Right
Now you're home so turn your own.

EXPLANATION for Everybody Chain:
As I said, the ladies do nothing more than

Grand Chain across, and back across, and so on until they are finally back at home with their original partner. The *men* are doing the work in this maneuver. The *Head Men* will chain with the man on their *right*, #1 man chaining with the #2 man; #3 man chaining with the #4 man. This means that the *Head Men* #1 and #3 men will be courtesy turning a lady in the #2 and #4 positions. The #1 man will be in the #2 position, but he will be turning the #4 lady who has chained across while the head men were chaining Right - The #3 man will be turning the #2 lady in the #4 position. The side men will be turning ladies in the *head* positions. . . Next the *same two Head Men* will again chain to their right - Side men will be chaining to their *left*. They continue chaining to the *left* all the way until they are back in their original home position. Head Men continue chaining to their *Right* until they are back in their original home positions.

Actually, each gent turns a lady in each of the positions and the 4th lady they turn will be their own partner, and they will all be back at home ready to take the next call. . . They are courtesy turning their partner when they arrive back home so it is easy at this point to put them into a *Tea Cup Chain* or into an *Island Chain* and you will find it very effective. Put them together and see what happens.

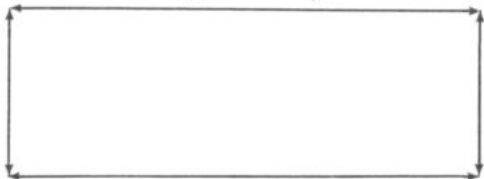
