President's Message

Here's an article I read on Leadership by Ralph and VeVe Hay of Aurora, Colorado that I feel is worth repeating:

"A leader is a person who accepts and exercises responsibilities which direct or influence the activities of others. Many traits are discernible in a good leader, but the essential ones are dedication, enthusiasm, ability to communicate, and a genuine respect for the opinions of others. To be most effective a leader needs to recognize the talents of others and delegate tasks accordingly, and must have the courage to make decisions that may be unpopular.

"In order to lead, one must lead toward something. Without a goal or objective leadership is vacillating and ineffective. Examples of goals for a square dance club are to increase membership, increase the number of visitors, improve the style of dancing, determine the level at which the club is to dance, plan non-dancing social activities, sponsor a demonstration group, increase club involvement in state and national dance activities, etc. Remember that a plan of action to reach identified goals and objectives will make their attainment much easier.

"A leader deals with three groups of people, each of which requires different tactics in order to make full use of their talents, knowledge, and abilities. The first is the group which actively supports the leader or the leader's objectives, the second is the group which actively opposes, and the third is the group in the center which waits to see which of the others becomes dominant and joins in with the majority. These groups are not static, individuals may shift from one group to the other depending on the issue or the leadership involved. The leader's goal is to expand the supportive group so that the noncommitted will fall in line. Bear in mind, however, that the opposition viewpoints must be heard and carefully considered. Ideas from this group may change goals, plans or objectives in ways which will be most beneficial to the organization.

"Leadership is a comprehensive subject which could be discussed in a week-long seminar and still leave many of its facets unexplored."

We need to seek ways to make leadership more appealing, more effective, and more rewarding, and how to provide training, guidance and tools to new dancers to enhance their leadership abilities.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The dancers of Florida can be extremely proud of their delegates. After a vigorous and ambitious working weekend schedule covering the 3rd weekend of January, the results are summarized as follows: - In answer to the question; "What happened on the working weekend?"

FINANCE COMMITTEE Chairman, Norm Farrell. A budget was estimated for the coming year.

CONVENTION PROCEDURES/CONVENTION FACILITIES Chairman, Mae Ford. Current guidelines for running a convention were revised and improved. Dimensions and major requirements were outlined to give convention facilities and planners an ideal list to provide for convention needs.

SHOWCASE OF IDEAS Chairman, Hugh Fultz. Plans were formulated to organize and present dancing in Florida in a showcase format at the coming National Convention in June at Louisville, Kentucky. Each area association is to assist, and the results will generate enthusiasm, interest, and information to dancers who are coming to Florida, or wish to learn from our ideas.

IRS/LEGISLATION COMMITTEE Chairman, Joe Vaccari. The application for IRS tax exempt status was reviewed with the request for Federal identification. Attachments consisted of constitution, by-laws, and 4 years of financial statements structured into tax returns.

The package was since furnished to an accounting firm in the Northwest Dancers Association for processing and coordination with the IRS until a determination is rendered. (As you may remember, the Federation will assist dancer associations' submissions upon request - after the successful determination is received by the Federation.) The support for making the temporary law recognizing Square Dancing as the National Folk Dance into a permanent law was unanimous. Ways of promoting the program and gathering more information are

in progress.

EDUCATION & SERVICE COMMITTEE

Chairman Belle Bishop. A new dancers booklet is in the making. Contents were selected and a format designed. A draft will be ready at the next meeting for submitting to the Florida Callers and the Round Dance Council with a view of joint approval and sponsorship. Hopefully, dancers will embrace this format to welcome and enlighten the new dancer to the world of dancing as we enjoy it.

An addition to the Federation Handbook for delegates was established to give criteria for input to square dance publications - authored by Boots Oglesby.

RECOGNITION COMMITTEE Chairman Walter Stokes. A more active and broadened program of recognition is envisioned outside the structure of the Hall of Fame. A guideline for recognizing general chairmen of the Florida State Convention was adopted.

HALL OF FAME Chairman Maurice Sogolow. The progress is heartwarming in the first activity of its kind at the state level. Formats for submission are in the hands of the associations. The first selections may be made in time for ceremonies at the next Florida "Come Dance With Me in '83" Convention.

Wow! I hope you are as uplifted as we were being part of this exciting meeting. You will have access to a lot more detail when your dancer association delegates get the official Minutes. Starting next month - A summary of each area association.

A DANCER SPEAKS UP

In the 23 years I have been square dancing, I have been aware of many changes in Western Square Dancing. Much is being said and written nowadays about the problem of levels of dancing, of how to keep both new and experienced dancers happy. I would like to talk about some topics that are related to the problem.

The first is what it means to me to "dance". Sometimes I get the impression at a square dance, that the folks on the floor are not so much dancing as they are going through a mental agility test of how well they can follow the directions of the caller, which they could do just as well without any music. To me, dancing should be a smooth rhythmic motion to enjoyable music, while keeping time to the beat. In a workshop, or workshop tip, while learning new material, why naturally one would expect pauses. But in a regular dance, the ideal is to keep moving in time to the music, not rushing to complete a figure, not standing still waiting for the next call, not pushing, not kicking (which may hurt somebody even in the next square), not bumping (which throws off the timing for beginners), etc. Of course, if dancers are young or young at heart, exuberant, high spirited, then by all means do what comes naturally, but try to be considerate of the other dancers in the square.

Speaking of being considerate, I am reminded of how many women I have heard complain about the rough treatment men give them. One woman had to have therapy for two years for a wrenched shoulder! Yet it is not just the women who get hurt. Sometimes women have a hand clasp or arm grip as strong as a man's!

Many beginning dancers do not know they are so strong, or else they are concentrating so hard on the calls, they grip tighter than they mean to do. Many women I have known are reluctant to tell a man that he has hurt them. It is a difficult thing to do. Is there a way that would not hurt the man's feelings?

Dancers need all the help they can get from the caller to remind them of the comfortable way to touch hands, to arm turn, to swing gracefully. Swinging can be beautiful, but it can also be painful, if the man tries to lift the girl half off the floor in a bear hug, especially

if the girl has back trouble. The caller does not see the tight, death-like grip on the elbow, he does not see the black and blue marks. He only knows about them when dancers tell him, and they do not like to complain. Maybe it would help to have more precise and frequent actual demonstrations by the caller, showing, for example, how to arm turn without using the thumb like a vise. I have suggested to a man that he not use his thumb to circle my arm, and he thanked me, for he said no one had ever told him about this, or if he had been told, he did not understand what was meant. Just as callers have to repeat over and over the same calls to beginning dancers, words of caution about "holding" need repetition.

The penalty for this offense in square dancing is that dancers will avoid getting into the same square with a person who is a "rough" dancer. And the rough dancer may not even know why he is often left standing on the floor while other squares form quickly.

One thing a beginning dancer can do to move more easily from class to club level is to listen intently to all the hints from the caller about the way to dance, and also, he can observe carefully the way an experienced dancer uses his (or her) hands and body as he follows the directions of the caller.

Another topic of interest (especially to beginning dancers) has to do with what happens when a square breaks down. As a long time devotee of square dancing, I have danced with many callers in several states, as well as at a couple of national conventions. I have danced in innumerable workshops at various levels, with small clubs, big clubs and singles clubs. Over and over I have been struck by how much dancing time is lost and how frustrated dancers are when the square breaks down and the dancers do not know how to get into lines, ready for the next call from lines. Over the past two years I have discussed this with many callers, and each had something different to say. One said it would not do any good, no matter how many times he taught a class how to get in lines, they could not do it anyway! Another said he did not use many calls between Left Allemandes. A well-

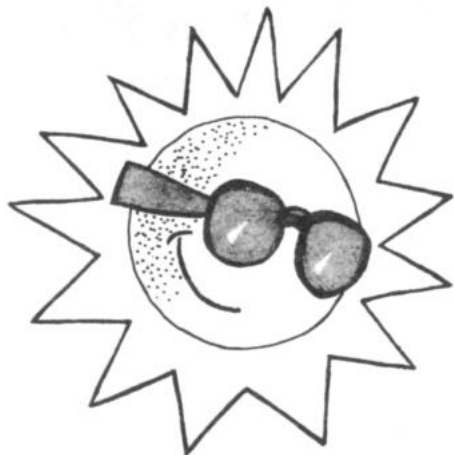

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills

THE LITTLE WONDER

(Another Venus & Mars figure)

This one came out in about 1950 and I put it on record at that time because it was such a nice figure and had a definite pattern, doing figure 8's and Stars. It was a precision dance and it had to be executed perfectly by the dancers to make it effective. Here is the call for it:

Number one couple Bow & Swing
Down the middle and Split the Ring
Couple on the right - left couple too
Foot couple cross and trail on thru
Now cut a figure 8 and away we go
Jents in behind your calico
Cut another figure 8 - make two stars
Make one like Venus and - one like
Mars

Now you trade them two stars round
about

The ladies weave in - the gents weave
out

Trade those two stars around again
The ladies weave out - the gents weave
in

Pick up your own when you come
around

Promenade the center of the town
First couple go left - next go right
Next couple left don't take all night
Last couple down the center - partner
trade

(pick it up here and do whatever you
want)

This one eventually works into the *Venus & Mars* figure but getting into and getting out are both a lot different. This one needs a complete breakdown so I'll start in right here and do that.

INSTRUCTIONS: First couple goes

down the center, the couple on the right (#2 couple), steps in behind them, then the #4 couple steps in behind couple #2, they all go through couple #3, gents separate and go *left*, ladies separate and go *right*, going up the outside to get back to the #1 position. Each gent follows the gent ahead of him, single file, all following the #1 gent, and the ladies follow each other the same way. - *As soon as the three couples go through the #3 couple, this couple will cross over* - gent following the gents, lady following the ladies. At this point we have all four gents on the Caller's *left*, all four ladies on the Caller's *right* - back near the #1 position

Now, and take it easy here, the #1 lady will cut across to end up behind the #3 man. The #1 man will cut across, going behind his partner, and he will end up behind the #3 lady. This is the figure eight part of the dance. Now the next lady cuts across to follow the #1 lady, the next gent cuts across to follow the #1 gent. Then the next lady crosses and her partner goes across, going behind his partner. Then the last lady crosses, and then the last gent.

Now they will repeat this - forming the two stars this time. Trade the stars once, then trade them again. The #1 man now takes his partner, promenades down the center, going to his *left*, the #2 gent takes his partner, promenades, going to his *right*, then the #4 gent will take his partner and promenade *left* to his home position. #3 goes down the center into place.

"THE TRAVELING DOLL"

I was amazed to learn that there are some square dancers that are not aware of the old and most fun tradition of passing square dance dolls from club to club. Any interested dancer can participate. Just take your dressed up doll along with a diary to your club dance and ask the caller to give it to a visiting dancer (usually they ask the dancer from the most distant club). In the front of the diary, write the owner's name, address, and the date you want the doll returned, and include the following instructions:

1. The caller is asked to give the travelling doll to a visiting dancer that is a member of a club and is wearing their club badge.
2. The caller will make note in his guest book of the name and address of the dancer taking the traveling doll.
3. The guest will send a postcard to the owner, giving their name and club name.

4. They then give the doll to their home caller to continue the chain.
5. Each caller, club officer, club officer, and the dancer taking the doll is invited to write in the diary.
6. Each club is asked to fasten a club badge on the traveling doll.

As time marched on with this tradition, the dancers have modified and bent the rules somewhat so that in the last five months I have seen - A pair of dancing dolls 18" tall; A 5' doll; A full size house door (it was announced that there was a door prize to be given away); A 3' Yogi Bear dressed in square dance attire; and a traveling banner. It's another one of those many fun things that square dancers do.

VENUS & MARS

I am going to give you the call for this one first and then we will break it down so that you can teach it yourself, and I ask that you notice the reaction of your dancers the first time you show it to them. They will like it, that I promise. Here is the call:

Ladies to the center - back to the bar
Gents to the center - right hand Star
Now back with the left - don't fall down
Pick up your partner with an arm around

Star promenade - go around the town
#1 lady step out and form two stars
One like Venus - and one like Mars
And turn 'em now - turn both stars
Now trade them two stars round about
Ladies weave in - the gents weave out
Now trade those 2 stars around again
Ladies weave out - the gents weave in
Then you pick her up with an arm around
In a Star Promenade - go round the town

That first call also came from many years ago. "Ladies center, back to the bar," means the ladies swoosh into the center, flip their skirts at each other and then back out. The gents make a right hand star, then back with a left hand star, pick up their partners and turn the star until the #1 couple are back at the #1 couple's home position. The #1 lady now slides out, raising her right hand to start the star. Each lady, starting with #4, then #3 and last #2 lady, steps into the Right

Hand Star. As soon as the #1 couple meet they trade places, gent moving into the ladies' star, lady moving into the gents' left hand star.

An important point is this: The ladies, each of them in their turn, slide across first, ahead of their partner, then the gents slide across, then the next lady, the next gentleman, etc. They trade stars once and then when they meet again they repeat the trade, ladies sliding back into their original right hand star, gents back into their original left hand star.

From here the call is directional. Pick her up with an arm around and the caller can take it from there. I find that a good thing to use here is "Back right out and make a *big* ring and circle left, Ladies Center, Gents Sashay, etc.". However, as I said, the caller can take it from there and do whatever he likes.

One other important point. When first teaching this movement, have each lady take the lead so that they can do it from any position they happen to be in. Here is what I am talking about. After you have the #1 lady lead out and start the two stars, when they are back in the "Star Promenade" then have the #2 Lady lead out and start the second star. When they are all back in the "Star Promenade" again, then have the #3 lady lead out, followed by the # lady and do the entire figure with each of them. Be *sure* that each lady, when leading out, does so in *her own home position*, or very near it.

known recording caller said he purposely gets his class mixed up, then teaches them how to get in lines. One caller said when *he* calls a dance, squares do not break down much!

The majority of callers thought it would be helpful if all callers would routinely teach their classes how to get in lines. Most callers favored having the couples in the head positions slide to their right, as the sides

make room for the line to form on the sides. Some callers favored having all dancers go to their home positions before forming lines. One nationally known caller thought the problem was worthy of being brought to the attention of CALLERLAB for discussion and possible recommendations to callers.

I would appreciate knowing what other dancers would like to say about these observations of mine.

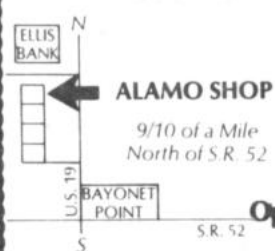

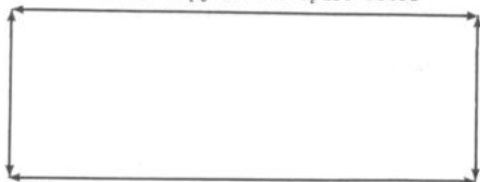
