SOUTHEAST FLORIDA SQUARE & ROUND DANCE ASSOCIATION

I. Organization

a. Membership

1. Southeast Florida Square & Round Dance Association is organized to provide services and give representation to all qualified Square and Round Dancers in its area.
2. Honorary Membership is awarded to any Dancer, Caller or Cues who has made a significant contribution to the Square Dance Movement in our area, however these Callers and Cues do not have voting rights.
3. Lifetime Membership is awarded to immediate Past Presidents upon the completion of their term of Office.
4. Each individual Member may vote at Membership Meetings.

b. Executive Board

1. The Executive Board consists of its President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. No Officer may serve more than two consecutive years in the same Office. These Officers are nominated in June, elected in July and are formally installed at the end of the last scheduled Dance (Clinic) in August. They start their term on Sept. 1st.

c. Board of Directors

1. This Board shall consist of: the Executive Board, the immediate Past President, an elected Officer of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers, the Editors of the Association Publication - 4W, and Delegates from area Clubs. The Delegates must be members, selected from each area Club, must be approved by the President and shall serve at his discretion.
2. Each member of the Board shall have one vote and may vote only in person at Board and Membership Meetings.

II. Objectives & Functions

- a. The purpose for which the Association was organized is to coordinate the activities and objectives of its Dancers with those of the Clubs, Callers and Cues and to promote and maintain high standards in all phases of Square and Round Dancing.
- b. To schedule activities for all Association Members, such as: Monthly Dances (Clinics); Annual Picnic; Annual Dance - Southeast October Spectacular, and Association Visitations to all local Clubs.
- c. To provide representation for its members at the State, Florida Federation of Square Dancers; National, United Square Dancers of America; and via Liaison Representation in the Southeast Florida Callers Association
- d. Meetings: Board Meetings are held on the first Monday of each month. Every Association Scheduled Dance (Clinic) on the second Sunday of each month is preceded by a Membership

A TIME FOR SETTING GOALS

Traditionally, in most parts of the country, Fall is the time for recruiting new dancers and starting square dance classes. Great enthusiasm is shown and much time and effort is expended by dancers and callers in trying to attract more people into the wonderful world of square dancing. This is to suggest that, along with this annual burst of enthusiasm, there should be a time of serious reflection on what is to be accomplished the next nine to twelve months. This should be *A Time for Setting Goals*.

Goal-setting should include an evaluation of past experience. What has been tried before? Did it work? If not, what went wrong? What improvements can be made? How many previous class graduates have we lost? Why? For many clubs, it is shocking to see how few graduates of the past several classes are still dancing with the club. Is it because those dancers were poorly taught and not prepared to cope with the real world of modern square dancing? Is it because they received the cold shoulder when they tried to integrate into the club? Questions such as these take courage to answer honestly. But honest answers can lead to positive changes.

Clubs and caller/teachers who rush new dancers through class simply so they can begin contributing to the club treasury and to "build up the clubs" are short-sighted, indeed. Those short-term graduates may pay dues sooner, but the statistics from around the country show that a disturbingly large percentage of them will pay a much shorter time and will soon be gone from square dancing. Some of our best, most respected caller/teachers, whose names are well-known to the dancing public, continue to tell us that they cannot teach the Mainstream program thoroughly in much less than one year. One wonders, therefore, how much less experienced caller/teachers claim to teach that program (and, usually, some Plus movements in addition) in classes of fifteen to thirty weeks duration. Classes are the very

foundation of square dancing, where dancers learn, or do not learn, the basics, customs, courtesies, traditions, dress, and all the other things that go to make a complete square dancer. They should not be looked upon routinely but should have definite goals with the good of the club, the new dancers, and square dancing in mind.

UNUSUAL OPPORTUNITY

Beginning on September 7, 1983, and continuing for 26 sessions, the Square Dance Community has an unusual opportunity. Specifically, *Western Squares*, a teaching series especially prepared and edited for television, will be aired at no charge to any station desiring to avail themselves of this service. The broadcast will be via Satellite Uplink by Southeastern Communications Association (SECA).

This series follows the wording, recommended styling and teaching sequence as published by CALLERLAB, the International Association of Square Dance Callers. This series of one-half hour shows will be broadcast in color with each of the dancer couples in appropriate matching outfits. The TV series uses a variety of camera angles including overhead. Demonstrations as well as "walk throughs" are used for teaching purposes. The 26-week series also includes some festival calling as well as interviews with some prominent people in the square dance community.

Those callers and dancers who own their own Video Cassette Recorders could tape the sessions and use them as reinforcement sessions for the dancers who missed one or more class sessions. It might also be used in remote areas where live callers and instruction are not readily available. Perhaps more important, however, is the opportunity we have to expose thousands of non-dancers to this wonderful recreation.

Please notify your local public television station(s) and advise them of the availability of the program *Western Squares* (Continued on Page 12)

through SECA and request your local station(s) to air the programs. By getting everyone behind this project, we could easily double the size of classes and dances each year for the next few years. Don't let this opportunity slip by.

Perhaps if one or more people in any given area tape these programs, an area effort could be made to provide remedial dance sessions with these tapes as the no-cost means of getting better dancers for all clubs. Try it! You can't lose!

QUARTERLY SELECTIONS

For the quarter beginning October 1, 1983, the Mainstream Quarterly Selection Committee has selected the movement "Ripple" for use during workshops at the Mainstream program. The definition of "Ripple", written by Curley Custer, is as follows:

From facing couples: Facing dancers join both hands with each other and circle half, then pass thru. Ends with dancers back to back. RIPPLE RIGHT, LEFT, IN or OUT. After doing the RIPPLE, dancers face in the direction indicated by the caller.

1. **RIPPLE** - Facing lines end with lines facing out, 8 Chain Thru ends with a trade by set up.
2. **RIPPLE RIGHT** - 8 chain thru start ends with right hand waves. Facing lines ends with right hand columns.
3. **RIPPLE IN** - 8 Chain Thru ends in Facing Lines - Facing Lines ends in starting Double Pass Thru.
4. **RIPPLE OUT** - 8 Chain Thru ends with lines facing out - Lines facing in ends in completed double pass thru.
5. **RIPPLE LEFT** will result in left handed formations but the dancers will have to adjust their ending position.

For the quarter beginning October 1, 1983, John Marshall, Chairman of the CALLERLAB Advanced Quarterly Selection Committee has announced that **SHADOW TO A DIAMOND** has been selected by this Committee as the 4th quarterly selection for 1983.

SHADOW TO A DIAMOND

From two-faced lines or waves, or 3 and 1 lines with the centers facing out, the ends do a normal Cast the Shadow, the center facing in will Extend and Trade, the center facing out will Split Circulate 1 1/2 to become the end of an ocean wave. The result will be diamonds in one of their various forms, right-handed, left-handed, facing, etc.

FLORIDA SQUARE AND ROUND DANCE HALL OF FAME

From any parallel two faced line, wave, or three & one lines with the centers in a scoot back position or mini wave position, the centers will start a remake action...Hinge..Centers trade..then Cast off 3/4 and spread apart as the ends do one circulate followed by one trade or crossover circulate. Waves end in waves, right hand waves end in left hand waves, and right handed two faced lines end back in right handed two faced lines. Three & one lines end back in three & one lines.

I have found that the Dixie Style Wave is a good starting point as the centers will start the remake with a right, and ending wave is right handed and in general a wave starting formation has the centers and ends working in opposite directions while from two faced lines they move forward in the same direction and this causes some minor traffic problems. I have them get acquainted with the action from Dixie Style Waves, boys as centers, then girls as centers. Next right hand two faced lines, boys as centers then girls as centers; then to waves which are right handed.

From Dixie Style Waves

Zero Line: Right & Left Thru..Dixie Style to a Wave..Change Lanes..Girls Trade..Recycle..Pass to the Center..Square Thru 3/4..Left Alle..(zero box)

Zero Line: Right & Left Thru..Dixie Style to a Wave..Boys Trade..Left Swing Thru..

Change Lanes..Boys Trade..

Boys Run..Wheel & Deal..Pass Thru..Trade By..Left Alle

Change Lanes from Right Handed Two Faced Lines

Zero Box..Swing Thru..Boys Run..Tag the Line Right..Change Lanes..

Couples Circulate..Bend the Line..Star Thru..Pass Thru..Left Alle..

Change Lanes from parallel right hand waves

Zero Box Wave: Change Lanes..Trade the Wave..

Swing Thru..Turn Thru..Left Alle...

Zero Box: Swing Thru..Change Lanes..

Girls Trade..Girls Cross Run..Grand Right & Left...

Change Lanes from Left handed Two Faced Lines

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher - Zephyrhills

LADIES CHAIN EQUIVALENTS

We have covered many of these in other issues but this time we are going to throw some of them together and see just how easy it is to change them around at will and make an interesting tip as far as the dancers are concerned — the callers too for that matter.

Right & Left Thru - Flutter Wheel - This is nothing more than a *Two Ladies Chain*.

Swing Thru - Turn Thru - Partner Trade - This also is simply a *2 Ladies Chain*.

Pass the Ocean - Recycle - and *Star Thru* - Just another — *Two Ladies Chain*.

Star Thru - Pass the Ocean - Recycle - turned the above around - *Two Ladies Chain*.

Of course there is the *Reverse Flutter* - and that's just merely a *Two Ladies Chain*.

Now we are going to use some of these things and change them around and see what happens.

Heads right and Circle to a Line
Star Thru - Pass the Ocean - Recycle
Now Bend the Line and - Pass Thru - Bend the Line and - Swing Thru - Turn Thru -

Now Bend it again and - Pass Thru - Now Bend it once more - forward & back (at this point each gent has partner back - and they are right back where they were when they circled to a line)

Right & Left Thru across from you - Turn your girl and - Flutter Wheel - Now Pass Thru and - Bend the Line - And Flutter Wheel just one more time (with opposite lady *IN* Sequence)

Star Thru - Dive Thru - Pass Thru -

Star Thru - Cross-Trail Thru - Left Allemande.

We said in an earlier issue that each Head Gent *must* chain once with each of the Side Gents to equalize the square - meaning that the #1 Gent must chain once with the #4 Gent, then he must chain with the #2 Gent to make everything equal. It's up to the Caller whether they will be *IN* or *OUT* of sequence. You can set them up so that they will be exactly where you want them to be. When we have

Heads Right and Circle to a Line

(They are *IN* Sequence of course) now we have them - **Star Thru -** (they are now *OUT* of sequence)

Dive Thru - Pass Thru - Star Thru - (they are still *OUT* - with opposites)

Now Pass Thru and - Bend the Line - (they are *IN* - still with opposites)

Star Thru (out) **Dive Thru** (still out)

Pass Thru (out) **Star Thru** (still out but back with original partners now)

Cross-Trail Thru - Left Allemande.

Most of these things we have covered before - but now we are putting them together just a little differently. The important thing is the fact that you can set them up to make certain changes and have them with the lady you want them with. This is chaining the ladies so as to be able to get them into any setup you might want them in. Here are some for instances:

Promenade now and don't slow down Gents Roll in, a left face whirl

A POSTAGE STAMP COMMEMORATING SQUARE DANCING AS THE NATIONAL FOLK DANCE

Four different designs for a commemorative postage stamp were submitted by the United Square Dancers of America to the Citizens Stamp Advisory Committee on August 19, 1982, with information copies to the Postmaster General and Congressman Earl Hutto, 1st District, Florida, who has given support to our effort.

The proposed postage stamps were designed by Mr. Jack Lorusso, a renowned Florida artist who is very active in the Square Dance movement. Jack's credentials as an artist are outstanding, including a career with the Federal Government as a designer and artist, and since retirement several award winning designs including the stained glass Memorial Window installed in the Hurlburt Field Chapel in Florida honoring the men killed in the Iranian rescue attempt.

Since the designs were submitted in August, 1982 they have been considered by the Citizens Stamp Advisory Committee at four separate meetings (the latest in March, 1983) without favorable action to date.

The Postal Code states that proposals should be submitted at least two years prior to desired issuance date. Also, correspondence received from the Assistant Postmaster General states that the 1983 stamps program has been completed and any favorable action cannot result in a stamp until 1984 or later.

Another obstacle is that the committee receives several thousand proposals each year and issues only about 18 or so each

year. Also, Postal correspondence makes continued reference to the block of four stamps depicting the different forms of dance issued in 1978.

It is the Committee's policy to reconsider a subject whenever there is a new expression of interest and proposals can be placed on the Committee's agenda for re-consideration.

United Square Dancers of America will continue to support the current effort of the National Folk Dance Committee to make permanent the designation (which will expire in 1983) of Square Dancing as the National Folk Dance.

Concurrently, we should flood the Citizens Stamp Advisory Committee and Postmaster General with Postcards and letters supporting the designs submitted by the USDA. This would show that there is Nationwide support for a postage stamp commemorating the Square Dance as the National Folk Dance. 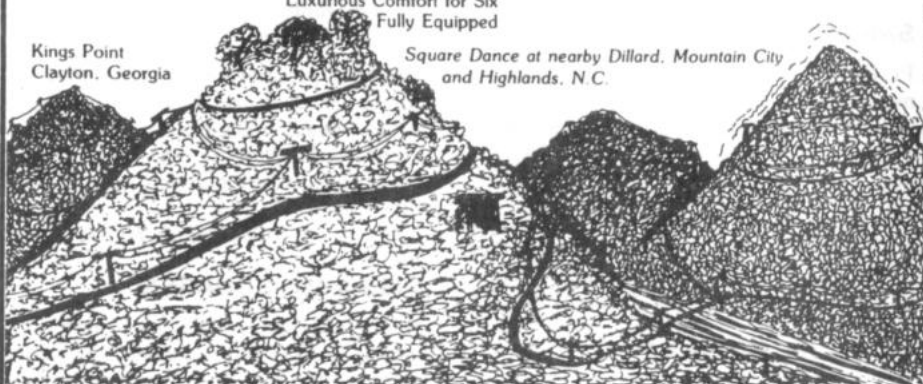

PICKING THE CLASSIC ROUND OF THE MONTH

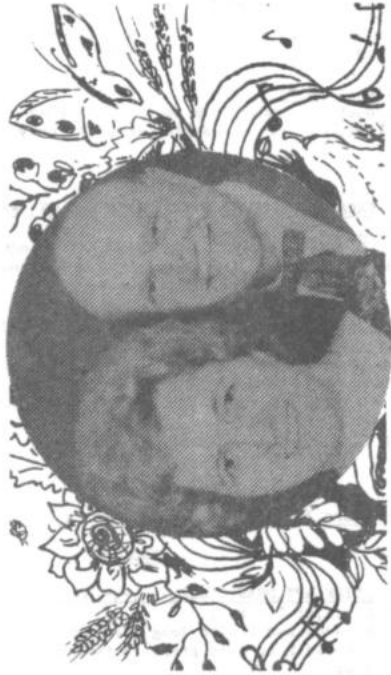

**One and Three will - Wheel Around
Star Thru - Dive Thru - Pass Thru -
Star Thru**

(with the right hand lady now *(OUT)*)

Pass Thru and - Bend the Line *(IN)*

Square Thru Across from you -

Count 4 hands and when you do -

Give a right to Mother, Pull her thru

Here comes corner, Left Allemande...

There are any number of ways that you can get them to the opposite lady from the one they are with, but the above is always there and you can make it work for YOU - in the above we started with the corner lady and the opposite of corner is the RIGHT hand lady - so we can set them up for any lady we want -

Head two ladies Chain to the Right

The new Side ladies Chain Across

**The Head Two couples - square thru
4 hands round to the outside two**

(each gent is now facing his *Partner* -)

**Curlique - Boys Scoot Back - Boys
Run**

(in lines of four, with partner, *IN* -)

To get the same effect we can start where they are facing Partners, after the Heads do the Square Thru - pick up at

Curlique - Walk and Dodge -

Partner Trade - Flutter Wheel -

At this point they are back with original partners, *IN* sequence and ready for your next call. Pick it up here and do whatever you want to do - just keep 'em dancing - never leave them waiting for the next call - just call something that you know will work even if you don't have any idea how you will get them out - do it anyway and give yourself a work-out hoping to work your way out. If you are not sure, you can do something that will get them into a promenade, and here is where you can take a look and see who they are with, and keep in mind that you can have them wheel around and do any number of things that will chain ladies into the position you want them in.

Don't be afraid to try - you will find it real easy - well fairly easy.

- g. Southeast Association continually strives to expand its membership and provide its services and effective representation for its members at the local, State and National levels. A Dancers Information Pamphlet is distributed to new Graduates and new resident Dancers. A principal objective for 1983 is to provide all possible assistance to the National Folk Dance Committee to make permanent the designation of the Square Dance as the National Folk Dance of the United States of America. (HR 1706).

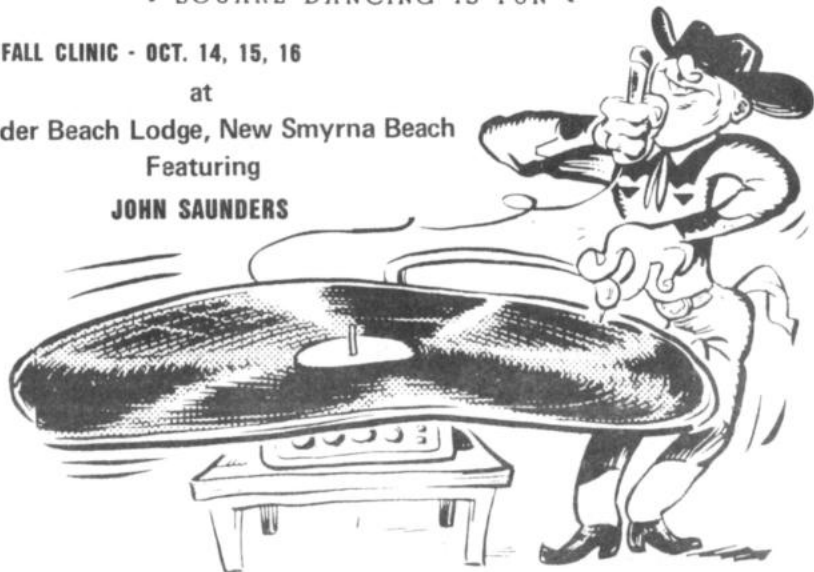

Should you fail to receive your magazine, you should first write us, showing your correct address, and we will check to make sure it is correct on the computer. **WE WILL RESPOND** to EACH INQUIRY of this nature. If the address is correct on the computer list, your next course of action should be to contact your local postman and/or your local Post Office. Don't hesitate to call your Post Office. If they can give you no answer for the delay of your copy, ask for PS Form 4314 which is a Consumer Service Card. Fill this out, following directions, and mail (no postage required). It is actually two cards - one goes to the local Postmaster and one goes to Washington, D.C. Now, the local Postmasters do not like to see these cards come in, because it means they will get inquiries from Washington, D.C. So this could generate a little action at the local level.

Once the mailing is in the hands of the Postal Service, we lose all control of it, and can assume no responsibility for anything not under our control.

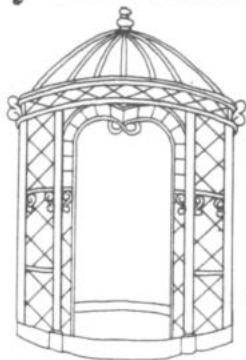

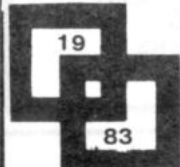

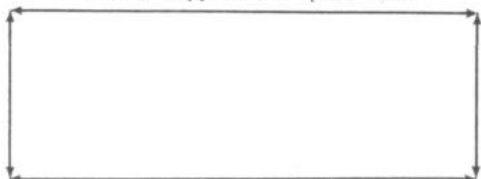
