When the change proposals are finalized, we will handle them by mail ballot. That should eliminate a long and boring legislative session at the meeting in May, and will allow each member to consider each proposal fully without rushing through them.

You will need a current copy of the Articles of Incorporation, the one that has "Revised October 1983" near the top of the front page. If you do not have a current copy, contact the Secretary, Harry Taylor and ask for one, but do it now. Don't wait until you get the change proposal because we will need the ballot back before the meeting. The ballots will have a cut-off date on them. Ballots received after that date will not be counted!

The tapes I made at the Arden Hopkin Clinic in New Smyrna Beach in October are available if anyone would like to make a copy of them. The quality is not what I had hoped for, but if you want to hear them, let me know. I'll be glad to loan them.

The City of MONTGOMERY Alabama welcomes you ! ! !

The 34th National Square Dance Convention will be held in Birmingham, Alabama June 27, 28, 29, 1985.

Montgomery is a paradox, the Cradle of the Confederacy and the birthplace of the Civil Rights Movement. A city of nostalgia, Montgomery blends the past and the future into a delightful potpourri of historic buildings, antebellum homes and modern shopping malls, not to mention Maxwell Air Force Base and our touch of Greece, Jasmine Hill Gardens, located between Montgomery and Wetumpka.

See our beautiful Capitol, a white domed Greek Revival structure which overlooks the city. On the west portico is a brass star which marks the spot where the first President of the Confederacy, Jefferson Davis, took oath of office. Nearby is the First White House of the Confederacy which was occupied by Jefferson Davis and which contains authentic furnishings and memorabilia of President Davis. The Lurleen B. Wallace Museum is also located in the Capitol Complex. Here you may view an audio tape on the life of Alabama's first and only woman Governor. Many of Governor Lurleen's personal objects are also on display. The Alabama Archives and History Building is located across Washington Avenue from the Capitol and houses collections from prehistoric artifacts to exhibits from the space age.

Jasmine Hill Gardens, high on the southernmost tip of the Appalachians, features a full scale reproduction of Olympic temple ruins. There are seventeen acres of flowers and statuary in "Alabama's Little Corner of Greece". A picturesque 1830's settler's cottage, formerly the home of the founders, is located within the garden. While in this

area, you don't want to miss Fort Toulouse, a French fortress located at the junction of the Coosa and Tallapoosa Rivers.

While in our Capitol City, you can lose yourself in time, smelling the fragrance of magnolia blossoms, visiting historic landmarks, cruising down the Alabama River on board our riverboat, sitting in a famous pew (the one in which Jefferson Davis worshipped) at St. John's Episcopal Church, or just strolling through the Old North Hull Street Historic District. Re-enter the present and join dancers at the Montgomery Area Square Dance Center located at 2201 Chestnut Street where local Clubs dance nightly.

JACK LASRY - HOLLYWOOD



WORKSHOPPING CENTERS OUT

The easiest way to approach *Centers Out* is from the completed Double Pass Thru Formation. I usually have the heads *Star Thru* then all *Double Pass Thru* and then stop the action and talk about the possibility of calling a *Centers OUT* rather than a *Centers In*. The call is easy to explain to the trailing dancers as all they do is step forward and apart to become the ends of a forming line. The trouble comes when the lead pair hears *CENTERS* and spreads apart as they would for a *Centers IN*. Their anticipation creates the problem.

Single File Circulate...Girls Facing Out...Run Right...Boys Trade & Spread...

Single Hinge...Centers Trade...Scoot Back...Boys Run...Star Thru...

TIPS FOR NEWER CALLERS

Les Gotcher

DAISY CHAIN

This little doozie is quite simple but it can really cause trouble if the dancers are not right on their toes. I called it to a group of better than the average "mainstream" dancers, and to my surprise they fell flat on their faces, not just once or twice, but time after time. Finally I stopped them and explained to them that they only had to be able to count up to 2. I also explained that I would be telling them which hand they were to use and all they really had to do was to listen to me. I called it like so:

Allemande Left like a Daisy Chain
Go forward two - and turn back one
That's a Right and a Left - turn back one
with a Right hand around -
Now go forward two - with a Left and a
Right and turn back one with a Left
hand around - Go forward two with a
Right and a Left and turn back one with
a Right hand around -
Now go forward two with a Left and a
Right and turn back one and -
There's corner, Left Allemande . . .

Now what in the world could cause trouble with something like this? Not only does the 'call' tell the dancers that they are going forward *TWO*, it also tells them exactly which hand they will be using and then it tells them exactly which hand they will use when they turn back one. Finally it boiled down to this: They didn't know which way to go when I said 'Go Forward Two'. They asked, "Which way is forward?" I broke it down for them by explaining that 'forward' meant the way they would ordinarily go in a 'right & left grand', men moving counter-clockwise, ladies moving clockwise. For the

life of me I couldn't figure out why this same group could do the *Teacup Chain!* They could do *Load the Top* and *Relay the Deucey* any many other complicated things, but a little thing like *Daisy Chain* could throw them.



When I arrived home from the calling job, I went into my little office and sat me down and started thinking about it. Of course the dancers finally were able to do *Daisy Chain* all right, and then they themselves wondered why they ever had trouble doing it. I think it boiled down to the fact that they had memorized all those complicated figures and could do them by 'rote', but the most important thing in square dancing, (to me that is), is to listen to the caller at all times. They had forgotten to do that and were trying to memorize the figure, and in something like *Daisy Chain*, if just one person makes a boo-boo it's all shot to pieces.

Next time out try this call. Tell them they must listen to you all the time and see how many times you have to do it over before they can get through it without having trouble. This should hold them for this month. Be sure and try this one though because it is a lot of fun and the dancers will have a good feeling of having accomplished something when they get through it.

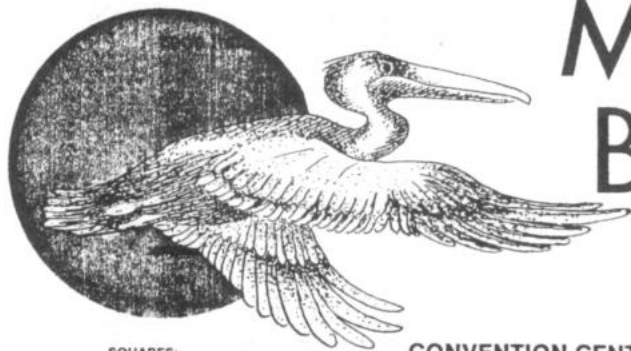
TRAIL BLAZERS

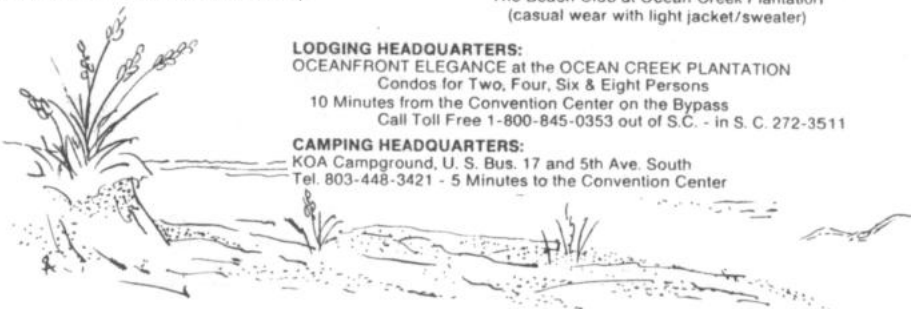

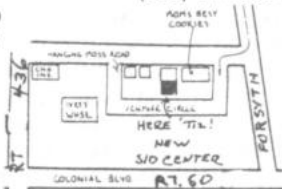

Keep in mind that the spreading couples are in mini waves and must keep their facing direction as they spread apart. If your Plus dancers have several years of experience, they should not have a great deal of difficulty, BUT if you have a group that rushed through Mainstream and right thru Plus, they may have problems due to the lack of DANCE TIME.

NEW PLUS QUARTERLY SELECTION

Gene Trimmer, Chairman of the CALLERLAB Plus Quarterly Selections Committee, has announced that the Plus Quarterly Selection for the three month period beginning February 1, 1985 is **PING TO A DIAMOND**. The definition, timing and dancing examples for this call are as follows:

PING TO A DIAMOND

(Author unknown) Starting formation is 1/4 Tag - Ending Formation is Center to Center Diamonds.

From any 1/4 Tag formation, everyone Extend the Tag once, all do one half of a Split Circulate, to form a diamond. Timing is four counts.

Teaching Hints: This call is most easily taught when the first walk-thru examples are started with same sex outside dancer couples, and same sex ocean wave dancers in the center. The resultant diamonds are either normal (girls as centers and boys as points) or 1/2 diamonds with boys as centers and girls as points. The first two routines in the examples use this method with all girls in the wave in the first example and all boys in the wave in the second example. In order to retain the flavor of the Ping Pong Circulate, the call from which this figure was derived, you can advise the outside couples to do a normal Ping Pong Circulate action and the wave couple start as in a Ping Pong Circulate but instead of the Trade at the end, just turn 1/4 to their right.

Dancing examples:

From a Static Square:

Heads Pass Thru, Separate Around One to Lines, Pass Thru, Wheel & Deal, Girls step to a wave, **PING TO A DIAMOND**,

Boys Swing Thru, Boys Single Hinge, Tag the Line, Boys U Turn Back, Star Thru, Promenade Home.

From a Static Square:

Heads Pass the Ocean, Swing Thru, **PING TO A DIAMOND**, (In the wave) Swing Thru, Cast Off 3/4, Girls Fold, Left Allemande . . .

From a Static Square:

Heads Spin the Top, **PING TO A DIAMOND**, (In the wave) Swing Thru, Single Hinge, Couples Circulate, Half Tag, Swing Thru, Boys Run, Wheel & Deal, Left Allemande . . .

From a Static Square:

Heads Touch 1/4, Girls Run, Pass Thru, Touch 1/4, Ends Run, Couples Circulate, Bend the Line, Pass Thru, Wheel & Deal Boys step to a wave, **PING TO A DIAMOND**, Center Girls Trade, Girls Single Hinge, All Tag the Line Left, Promenade Home.

From a Static Square:

Heads Pass the Ocean, **PING TO A DIAMOND**, Outsides Circulate, (In the wave) Swing Thru, Single Hinge, Half Tag, Swing Thru, Boys Run, Wheel & Deal, Left Allemande . . .

From a Static Square:

Heads Pass Thru, Separate around one to a line, Pass Thru, Wheel & Deal, Girls Step to a wave, **PING TO A DIAMOND**, Flip the Diamond, Right & Left Thru, Left Allemande . . .

Other editors along the way were Ricky Holden, Rod LaFarge, and Frank Kaltman. Stan & Cathie Burdick became editors in 1968 and in 1972, they replaced the word *American* and the magazine title then became *American Squaredance*.
