NEW! NEW! NEW! Video Promotion Project (Available Online) If you are looking for a video resource to help you recruit or retain dancers we can help! The ARTS has created videos with information about the many benefits of dancing. Links to the videos are intended to be posted and shared throughout the dancing community. As the videos become available links will be posted, shared and publicized. All clubs are encouraged to help publicize these videos. The goal of this project to produce short (90-second) videos which would be available via a URL link on the web. These videos will support the marketing & promotion of our great activity. Michael Streby has taken the lead for this project. These videos provide information about the many benefits of dancing. We are pleased to report that the first five of six 90second videos is available online. The videos feature Dr, Douglas Lee as he discusses the many benefits of dancing. In the first video he points to the Emotional and Psychological benefits participants gain. He emphasizes that dancing provides exercise and positive socialization, which is equally,

if not more, beneficial. He notes that dancers experience happiness. In the second video he notes that Square Dancing helps fight one of the very serious health issues diabetes - by helping increase insulin resistance. In the third video, he reports dancing helps strengthen muscles and helps increase balance. Both of which are VERY important as we age. In the fourth video, Dr. Douglas Lee notes that Square Dancing helps improve the quality of life for people suffering from early dementia. Square Dancing involves physical activity and requires participants to make mental decisions, both of which help fight early dementia. (NEW!) In the fifth video, Dr Douglas Lee discusses the very valuable social aspects of dancing, including many activities outside of the actual square dance. These activities include picnics, day trips, celebrations such as the 4th of July, and many others. This type "outside" gatherings helps build what has been named "social capital." The videos are posted on the ARTS web site under "Promotion Videos": www.ARTS-Dance.org "Doctors say that Square Dance movements raise heart rates like many good aerobic exercises should. All the changes of direction loosen and tone up the muscles — but not so severely as to cause injury. In Square Dancing, when you're not moving, you're clapping hands and tapping your feet, which all contribute to long-term fitness." Square Dancing may look complex to nondancers. However, new dancers learn one move at a time, practice that move, then learn another and another. After a series of lessons, new dancers blend in with experienced dancers. After retiring and moving to Florida in Dec. 2006, Ann & Ivan happened on a flyer about square dance lessons, thus was born a new hobby! It was such fun, and they met so many friendly people who later became good friends. Along with square dance lessons, there was also round dancing. Ivan's brother-in-law, Don Graves, sometimes came along to listen to the music. Don was completely blind as a result of an accident. He expressed an interest in learning to round dance. Always read for a challenge, Ivan said "sure, we'll give it a try". Our club cuer showed him how to look up cue sheets and the music. Don & Donna would dance up and down the center aisle of their barn with Ivan playing a taped son and Ann teaching them the steps. She was still learning the steps herself at the time! That's how it all got started. Don & Donna did learn to dance, and they all joined the Dixie Dancers. After that they joined the Square Wheels Square Dance Camping Club. Ann became their cuer and Ivan was affectionately referred to as her "roadie". After he got her equipment set up to cue, you could usually find him selling 50-50 tickets. Even when it became hard for him to dance, he loved visiting with

everyone. A year or so ago they joined the High Springs Dance Club where she cues, and he continued to be her "roadie". Many thanks to all the callers and cuers who helped along the way.


