PERSONAL TRIBUTE TO BOB COURTER

Our world of Square Dancing lost a very dedicated square dancer. **Bob Courter** passed away on October 30, 2011, at his home after a short illness. He is survived by his wife **Jennie** of 56 years, three sons, two daughters-in-law, eight grandchildren, and one great-grandson.

Bob and Jennie began square dance lessons as snowbirds 20+ years ago. They were very active, holding every office in the **Left Allemanders**, and in the West Coast Association. After moving to the Villages they joined the **Orange Blossom Squares**, serving in the offices of Secretary, President Elect twice, Training Directors, and Presidents. Bob and Jennie just took the Presidency for the second term October 1st. As CFA dancers, they joined the CFA. Their first position was Area Directors, then Presidents for two years. They chaired the **Shamrock Swing** for two years, asst. chairpersons one year, and 2012 co-chairpersons. We can't forget the Florida Square and Round Dancing Conventions. They always were willing to help. One year they served as Education Coordinators, and another year as Treasurers.

In addition to square dancing, Bob enjoyed golf, wood working, doing jigsaw puzzles, and, most of all, spending time with his family.

Bob served in the US Army during the Korean War. His funeral mass was held on November 4th, with permanent placement of the urn at the National Cemetery in Bushnell.

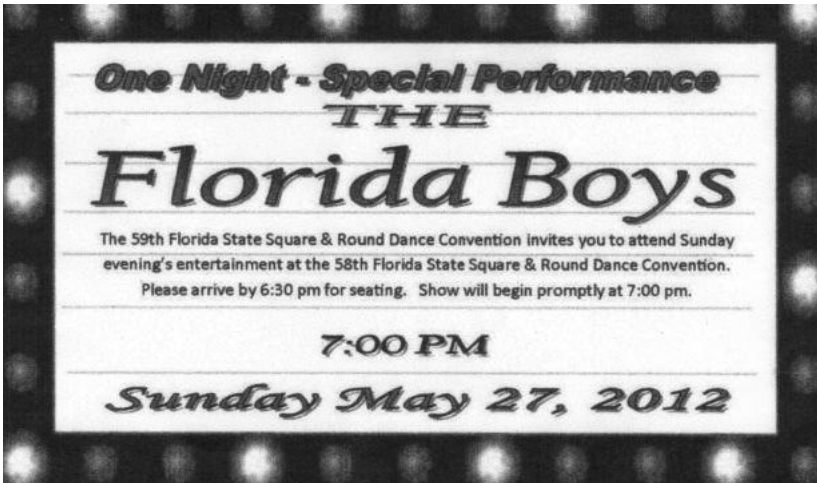
OTHER

Whirl & Twirl Turns 50!

(Written and compiled by proud members of Whirl & Twirl)

In June 1962, the Whirl & Twirl Square & Round Dance Club was formed from two other clubs: the Elk's Twirlers (Joe Curtis, caller) and the Whirlaways (Joe Johnson, caller). The clubs were sponsored by city recreation departments. The December 1962 issue of Bow & Swing announced that Whirl & Twirl would hold intermediate-level dances at Orlando's Robert E. Lee Junior High School with Joe Curtis calling. As "new kids on the block" the club was competing with more established clubs. In just over a year, the club gained notoriety when Joe Johnson took over as caller. After putting on a square dance demo at the County Fair, Whirl & Twirl was headed for bigger and better things.

Another big change came in December 1963 when Danny Robinson hit town from the hills of West Virginia. Under Danny's calling, the club really took off. In 1965, he started the Tenderfoot/Big Foot concept and began dancing on Wednesday and Friday nights, a format that continues today. By 1967, no longer sponsored by the city recreation departments, the club wandered from hall to hall, like nomads, for about 2 years. Finally, in August 1969, the club settled into Slovak Gardens where we spent the next 15 years.

In 1970, at Danny's suggestion, Pete and Jan Shankle formed their first formal round dance class. They had been providing informal classes since 1969. Rounds continued under the Shankles until 1981 when Dick and Darlene Nordine stepped in and became club cuers. In 1987, after Dick's job took him overseas, Roy Brown began playing some of Dick's tapes. Following one of Dick's taped dances, Danny made an announcement, "Be sure and be here next Friday night as Roy Brown is going to try cueing a round dance live, not off the tape. He's going to learn to cue." So, in January 1988, Roy Brown became Whirl & Twirl's own home-grown cuer.

In 1983 Slovak Gardens would not renew the club's lease so the great search began to find a new location. In October 1984, a vacant, non-air-conditioned, bare, dirty warehouse was found. A giant renovation and relocation effort was put forth and, on the appointed weekend, a great motorcade descended on Slovak Gardens. In less than one day, the club's assets were moved—lock, stock, and wagon wheels. Through great determination and perseverance, not one regular dance date was missed. Soon, with a great many contributions and hard work, a new dance facility was born: The Hanging Moss Square Dance Center. Good times, good fellowship, and outstanding dances soon gave Whirl & Twirl the reputation we still enjoy today as a great place to square and round dance.

For many years, it had been the dream of Whirl & Twirl to own its own dance facility. Armed with our past experiences and this dream, a building fund was established and nurtured over the years. After a lengthy search and a lot of hard work, our dream finally became a reality. On January 15, 1995, we celebrated the grand opening of our new dance facility—The Whirl & Twirl Square and Round Dance Center on Venture Circle off Hanging Moss Road. The building was designed *by* square and round dancers *for* square and round dancers with the mission of encouraging you to come back time after time.

In September 2004, Roy Brown retired as club cuer after 17 years. We were all sorry to see him

go. The club continued with guest cuers until early March 2005 when Pete and Jan Shankle returned as club cuers after a 23-year absence. Sadly, Pete passed away in 2011 and Jan bravely continues on as club cuer.

In February 2006, Danny Robinson was preparing to do what he loved best, calling at a big dance, when he suffered a massive CVA and died February 24, 2006. This was a great loss to the club. He had called at Whirl & Twirl twice a week for over 42 years. Danny was a gentle giant, both in stature and in talent. We all have cherished and special memories of Danny. He will be forever missed for his credo of Leave Your Troubles Outside the Door. Danny's contributions to the success of Whirl & Twirl are immeasurable.

After a long search and many auditions, Paul Place was named club caller in July 2006. Paul made it his goal to enhance the dance experience and began with a workshop prior to the Wednesday night dance to help Mainstream dancers improve their skills as well as offering advanced workshops like DBD. Sadly, in April 2008, Paul was diagnosed with inoperable cancer. He and his wife Linda moved back to his beloved Auburn, AL, to be near family. On July 9th and 11th, Paul returned to the club to call his last two dances to over 18 squares of dancers both evenings, finishing with "The Cowboy Rides Away." On August 19, 2008, Paul passed away and was buried with full military honors.

In August 2008, Whit Brown then became our club caller. Whit learned to dance at Whirl & Twirl in the early '70s, and in 1977 began his calling career with Danny Robinson as a mentor. Whit, accompanied by his wife Dee, took up the reins at Whirl & Twirl and, for Whit, it seemed he had come "home."

We will observe our golden jubilee this coming June with two days of celebrations! Friday, June 1st, will be a members-only party in which all members will join together in a tribute to a half-century of fellowship at our club. Members will be able to witness the effort that has gone into documenting and presenting the history of the club and learning a little about the many characters who have contributed so much over the years.

The second evening, Saturday, June 2nd, you are all invited to share our joy. It will be a fun Mainstream dance hosted by national caller Jet Roberts with Jimmy and Carol Griffin from Tampa cueing rounds. Come join the celebration!
