One of Square Dancing's great “giants”, who promoted square dancing for 57 years, has taken square dancing to a higher level. Al “Doc” Hixon died on June 14 at his home in John Knox Village, Orange City. He was 92 years old. He and his lovely sweetheart, Martha, had been married 72 years. They have four children, Bill, Kathy, John, and Lee. A bomber pilot in World War II, a career as a veterinarian, he and Martha “opened their homes and hearts to many young people in need of a place to stay.” Dixie Squares, Daytona Beach, began with “Doc.”

The club was started 60 years ago. Many have shared with Doc and Martha in squares throughout the area. Have you ever played dominoes with Doc and Martha? What an experience losing gracefully to them. The memorial service was held in the Presbyterian Church at Port Orange. His son-in-law, Rev. Calvin Gittner (wife, Lee) officiated. Many from clubs around the area filled the church and listened to family reminisce about this humble man. True to his faith and life, his body was given to the Univ. of Fla. For research. "This is Daddy's last act of giving back to others to help doctors to learn their profession," his daughter Kathy Brown said. JB
