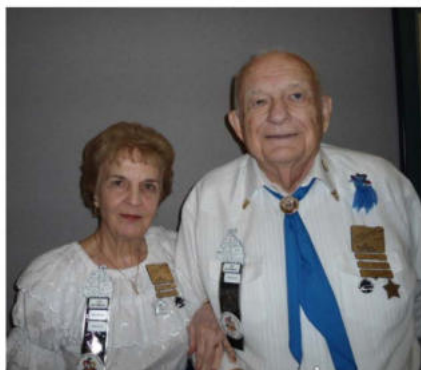

THE PAUL PLACE SCHOLARSHIP

On April 2, the third annual Paul Place Memorial Dance took place in Daytona Beach, FL. The memorial dance was held to honor **Paul Place**, a dedicated and supportive member of CALLERLAB for more than 25 years. The dance was hosted by the Dixie Squares of Daytona Beach, with their caller, **John Swindle** programming the dance with callers in attendance.

The dance was well attended with callers from around Central Florida. The following callers donated their time and calling skills to make sure the dancers in attendance had a memorable evening; **Rod Barngrover, Bill Boyd, Whit Brown, and John Swindle**. We would like to thank the callers and dancers of Central Florida for their continued support.

On behalf of the CALLERLAB Foundation **John and Gail Swindle**, accepted a donation from the Traveling Hoedowners in support of the memory of Paul. The Traveling Hoedowners and Paul recorded several square dance videos which have proved to be helpful to students and others. John explained the purpose of the Foundation and the scholarship programs. The terms of the Paul Place Memorial Scholarship are available through CALLERLAB and the Foundation. New callers or seasoned callers may apply for assistance from the Foundation to attend a CALLERLAB Caller-Coach Accredited Caller's School. Applications are available online at www.CALLERLAB.org.

The Paul Place Scholarship is administered by the CALLERLAB Foundation. This year the dance in Daytona Beach raised \$1,001 to add to this scholarship. We are very pleased and proud with the efforts of all the dancers in Central Florida and callers for their support and attendance at this dance.

FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

The CALLERLAB Foundation Mission Statement reads, in part: "The mission of the CALLERLAB Foundation is to preserve and promote the folk art of American square dancing and related dance forms."

The following scholarships are available from the Foundation.

The **Dave Krediet** Memorial Scholarship Fund. In accordance with the wishes of Dave's family, proceeds from this scholarship fund will be used exclusively for disbursement to any caller wishing to attend a caller's school.

The **Paul Place** Memorial Scholarship Fund. In accordance to the wishes of Paul's family, proceeds from this scholarship fund will be used exclusively for disbursement to any caller wishing to attend a caller's school with emphasis to newer callers.

The **Grand Square, Inc.** Scholarship Fund is available to callers, who have indicated a desire to learn to call or a desire to improve their calling, or a square dancer or organization which has indicated a desire to sponsor a seminar or clinic to provide training to dancers or callers to help them better serve square dancing.

The **Kenneth Reid** Memorial Scholarship Fund. Proceeds from this scholarship fund will be used exclusively for disbursement to any caller wishing to attend a caller's school.

The **General CALLERLAB Foundation** Scholarship Fund. Proceeds from this scholarship fund will be used exclusively for disbursement to any caller wishing to attend a caller's school.

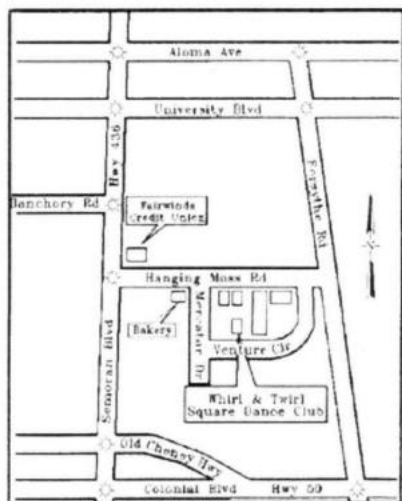
