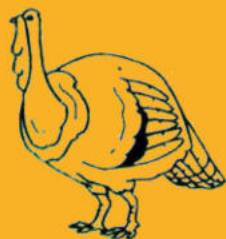

From Michelle Mabie:

We need all of your help and support!! Thanks to Tom Miller, National caller from PA, and Lee and Barbi Ashwill, NEC Members from the Portland National, there is a proposal before the NEC to have a reduced rate for Handicapable Dancers at the National Square Dance Conventions. This is a wonderful thing!! As we all know, conventions are a big expense for our dancers. Many clubs choose to go to the Handicapable Square Dance Convention or local conventions and not the National Square Dance Convention. Since 2003, the NEC has been VERY supportive of the Handicapable Hall and we have the best line up of callers at the convention (my personal opinion, of course!!). We have callers asking us to call in the hall and the word continues to get out about how great our hall is!!

Put On Your Dancing Shoes

Dancing is a great way for people of all ages to get and stay in shape. It is a fun way to be social and reduce stress. But one benefit of dance that you may not know is that it can actually make you smarter.

Dancing increases serotonin levels, the neurotransmitter responsible for enhancing many of the brain's functions, both directly and indirectly. And increased serotonin levels enhance learning abilities and improve memory.

A 21-year study of senior citizens, aged 75 and older, led by the Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York City, funded by the National Institute on Aging, and published in the *New England Journal of Medicine* objectively measured mental acuity in aging people by monitoring rates of dementia, including Alzheimer's disease.

The study wanted to see if any physical or cognitive recreational activities influenced mental acuity. The study showed that some activities had a significant beneficial effect while other activities had none.

One of the surprises of the study was that almost none of the physical activities appeared to offer any protection against dementia. There was one important exception: the only physical activity to offer protection against dementia was frequent dancing which reduced the risk of dementia by 76 percent.

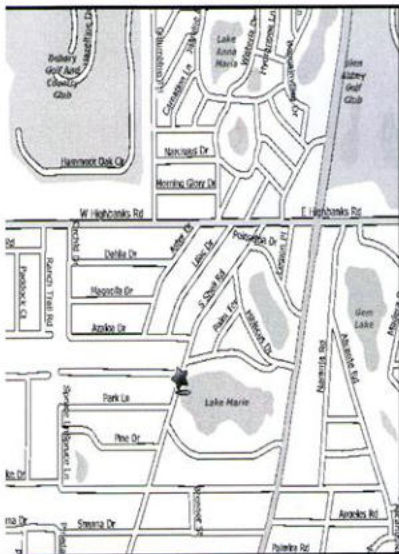

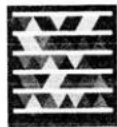
