PING TO DIAMOND (Author Unknown) Starting formation is 1/4 Tag-Ending formation is Center to Center Diamonds.

Definition: From any 1/4 Tag formation, everyone Extend the Tag once, all do one half of a Split Circulate, to form a diamond.

Tying: four counts.

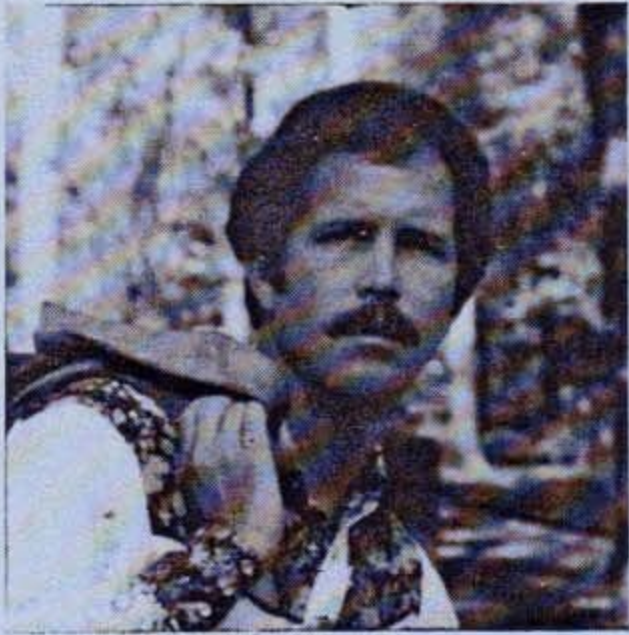

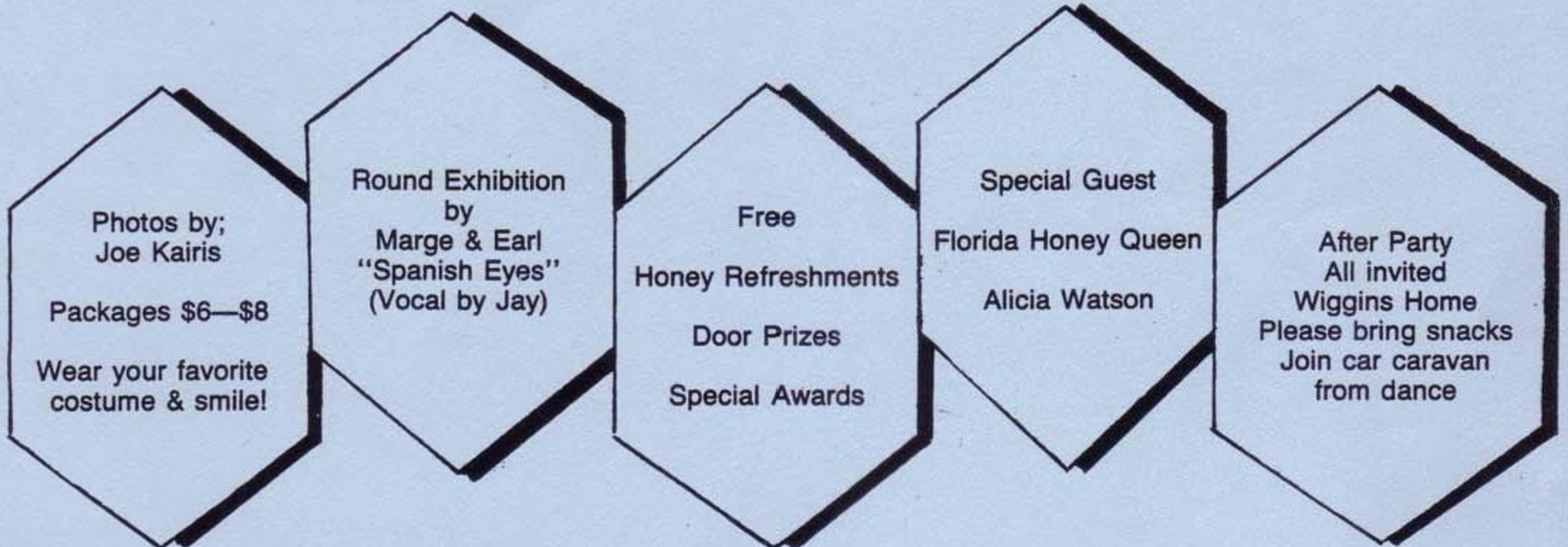

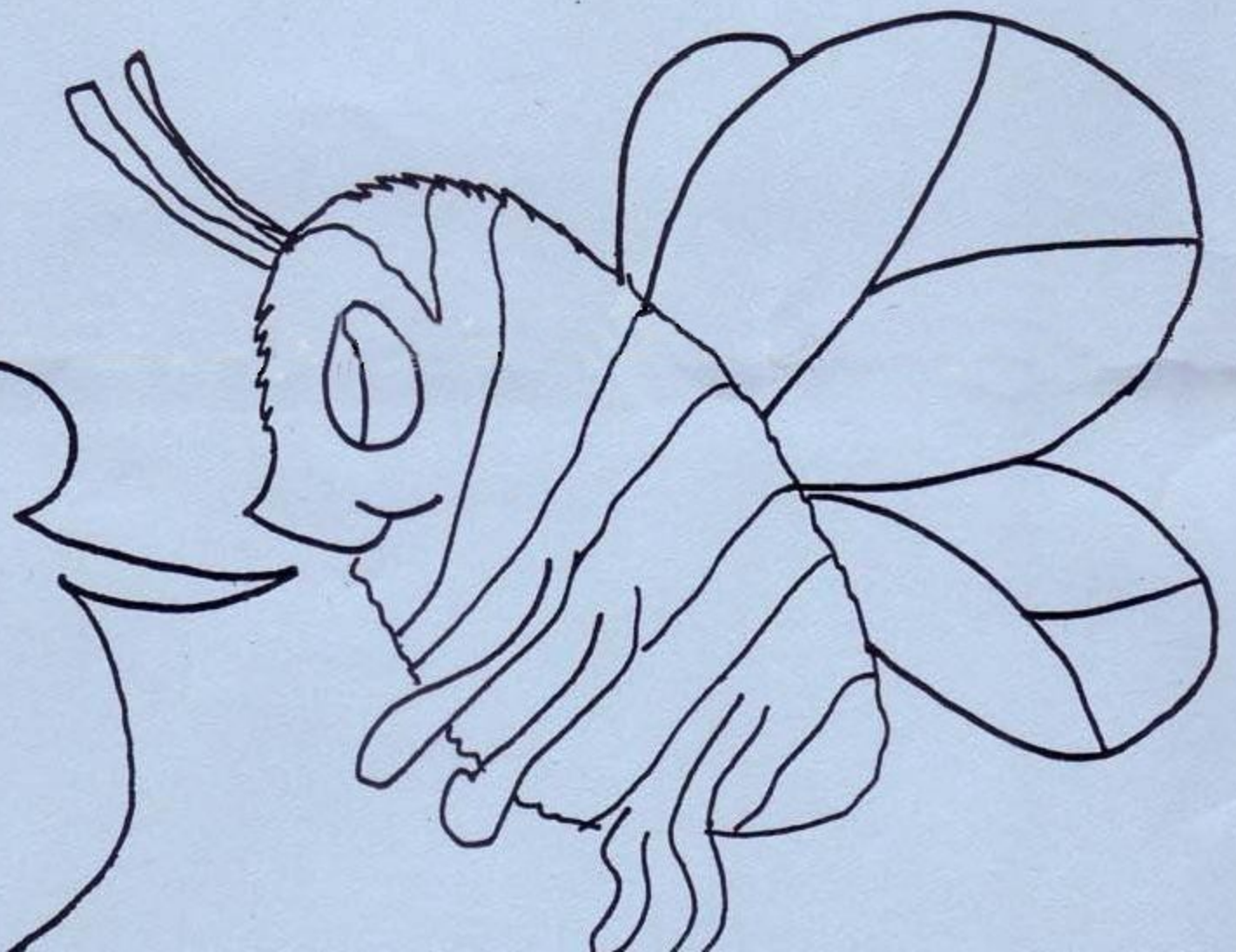
