Including the callers' partners, the total attendance was approximately 800. 27 callers represented Florida. VIP guests included Steve & Dorothy Musial and Vic & Peg Wills from the National Executive Committee; Don & Pete Hickman and Irv & Betty Easterday represented ROUNDALAB, while Doc & Peg Tirrell and Bob & Dottie Elgin represented LEGACY.

Overseas callers attending were Ivor Burge, Australia, Jac Franssen, The Netherlands, Hans Gietl and Andreas Macke from West Germany, and John Smith from England.

Quarter Century Certificates were presented to 30 callers, including Frank Bedell and Oscar Erwin from Florida.

MESSAGE FROM THE 1983
STATE CONVENTION CHAIRMAN

Three couples have been selected for induction into the Florida Square & Round Dance Hall of Fame. Those being inducted on Sunday afternoon, May 29, are Kay & Ed Mack, Jim & Helen Galloway, and Gene & Ima Baylis. The criteria used was; (a) at least ten years involvement in the Florida square and/or round dance activity, and (b) a significant effect statewide as a teacher, leader, organizer, and/or promoter.

A plaque in the dimensions of 11 1/2" x 14", and a resume' will be placed in the Hall of Fame. The family of the inductee will receive a smaller version of the plaque.

Kay & Ed Mack were one of the original Knothead couples, and were deeply involved in round dancing. For many years Ed was known throughout the country as the 'Clown Prince of Rounds'.

Jim & Helen Galloway were one of the original couples of Knothead. Both remained active in the Knothead Convention as Chairman and Treasurer.

Gene & Ima Baylis were involved in both squares and rounds. They were instrumental in organizing the Round Dance Council of Florida with Gene as its first president. Gene was the caller & teacher for the Square Wheelers, a wheelchair club & exhibition group. He was active in the Florida Callers Association serving as president in 1957.

The screening committee would like resume's for nominees living or dead who were most active prior to 1966. As of March 28th, 1983 total registrations had reached 21,497 with registrants from as far away as New Zealand and Saudi Arabia. This goes to prove that the Place To Be in 83 is Louisville, Kentucky on June 23rd, 24th, & 25th.

The Parade of States is a spectacle to behold and will be quite pleasant this year as it is to be held in the "cool, cool, cool of the evening" in the Fairgrounds Stadium. The parade will begin at 7:00 pm. EDT with the lineup forming at 6:15 pm. on the West side of the Stadium. In case of rain-Heaven Forbid- the Parade of States will be held in Freedom Hall.

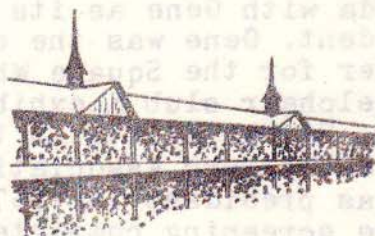
colorful jockey uniforms to the models from 37 States and Saudi Arabia this promises to be a Fashion Show you won't want to miss.

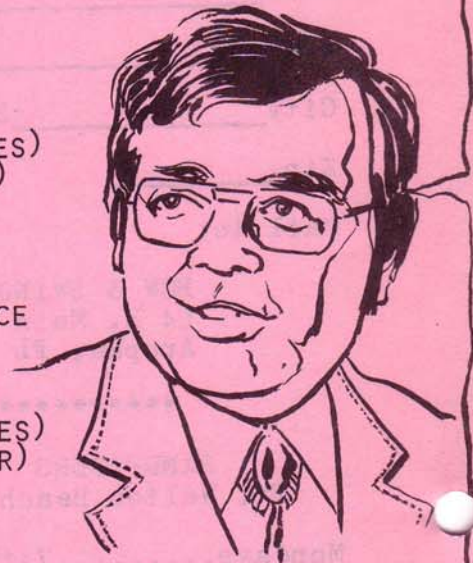

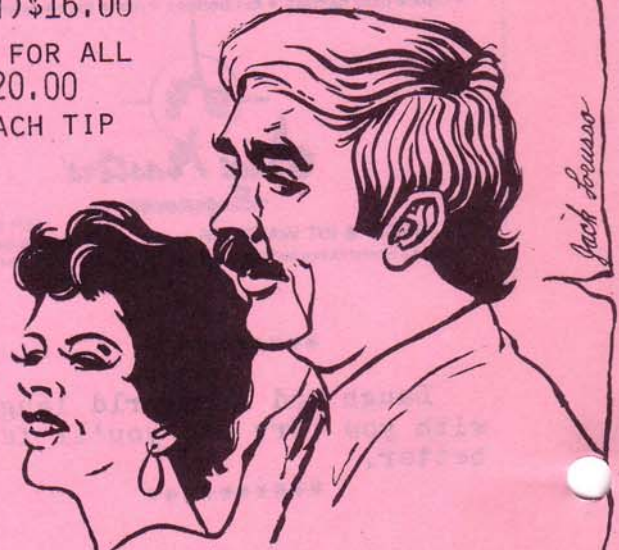
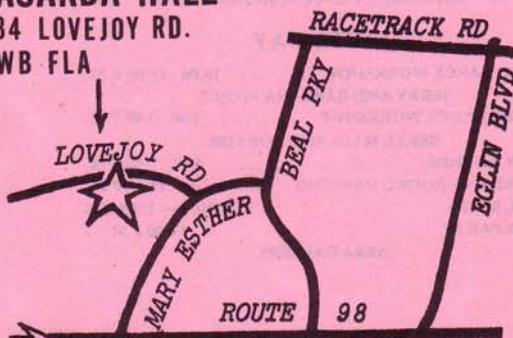
