Roll Call: Quorum present. Quorum consists of 25% of Board of Delegates (Board of Delegates:

Delegates from member area associations, member clubs, delegates-at-large, and the Executive Committee). Currently 14 / 25%= 4.

Minutes: April 20, 2024, minutes approved with edits.

Note: New club joining NWF soon – Emerald Waves Squares, per Tim Tharp.

Financial Reports: See 2nd Quarter Financial Report. Starting Checking Balance is \$6,729.10; Ending balance is \$7,345.08; savings are \$4,818.58. CD is \$4,185.71; account total is \$16,349.37. Note: donation to Ragan Hall will be reflected on next quarter; previous donations were already reported. Profits from 69th Convention can be donated forward for next convention. Discussion is held regarding a benefit dance for the next convention. Motion is made to donate profits to the next convention. Motion is seconded and approved. Treasurer

will send to 70th Convention Chairman.

Roundup 2024: Still trying to get ribbons; searching for a new vendor. Need to order 100 to get price break. The Roundup will be held on October 25-26, 2024, in Pensacola at Ragon Hall.

Roundup 2025: Chairperson is checking for a nationally recognized caller. Looking at hotels in the area and need to obtain information for the contracting of a Rounds Cuer. We will send the NWF Roundup Guide to Tim, DeeCee will handle. Tim is also wondering about the budget and schedule rotation. He would like to increase attendance to ensure sufficient profitability. The 2025 Roundup is October 24-25, 2025, to be held in Panama City.

2025 NWF Nomination Chairperson: still working on candidates.

Panhandle Press: Electronic versions are sent to members and magazines; hard copy only to clubs. Expenses are paper and ink. Still an affordable effort and worth continuing. Clubs should make sure their dance schedules are up to date; provide updates to Barbara.

Bylaws: no updates.

Florida Federation: Next Federation meeting is November 3 at St. Catherine's in Jacksonville. We need a delegate to attend. November 9 is a benefit dance for the next convention in Wildwood (near Villages). Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention is January 17-18, 2025, in Deltona, FL. Herb and Carol Cumbie (recent student graduates) are now in Texas with their daughter as she undergoes immunotherapy for cancer. Keep them in your prayers.


A long time member, Pat Tilman, will have a knee replacement on Oct. 21, but we hope to see Pat and Travis on the dance floor in 2025!


