Treasurer/Insurance: See 3rd Quarter Financial Report. Starting checking balance is \$7,345.08, Ending checking balance is \$6,942.98. Savings ending balance is \$4,818.70. CD ending balance is \$4,234.43. CD matured 09/24/2024 and was reinvested Account total is \$15,996.11. Insurance link is on the USDA website. Forms are fillable on-line. Alec explained procedures & requirements. USDA has not set the 2025 dancer rate. Alec will let clubs know once it is set. Paperwork needs to be submitted to Alec before 12/15/2024. Any questions, contact Alec.

Roundup 2024: Deecee Haslett reported the Roundup is in full swing, although attendance on Friday night was down.


