Tour Package Cost

\$7,980 per person, double occupancy \$15,960 per couple double occupancy Includes – Round trip airfare & land package

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. Private rooms are available for an additional \$400 per person.

Registration is on a first come first served basis. These tours typically sell out. We strongly suggest early registration to reserve your space.

<u>Registration deposit:</u> To reserve your space, send a minimum deposit of \$250 per person. Personal check, money order or Zelle only please. You will receive a confirmation. To keep costs down, we do not accept credit card payments. You may cancel with a refund on all deposits any time prior to November 1, 2025, less a \$50 per person admin fee.

November 1, 2025 Second payment of \$4,000 total per person is due and \$2,000 is nonrefundable. We will start booking airline tickets at this time. Once you receive your airline booking, we request a confirmation.

<u>June 1, 2026</u> Final payment is due and 100% is non-refundable. Tour cancellation and medical travel insurance is highly recommended.

Passports: Must be valid a minimum of 3 additional months from your return date. Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend cancellation & medical insurance after November 1, 2025 when half your tour cost is due. Travel insurance protects 100% of your investment due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you or your traveling partner. It also includes lost baggage, missed connections, medical expenses and emergency assistance. You can review different insurance plans by going to USI Affinity Travel Insurance or we can give you a quote for this protection. This is a separate insurance plan and is not connected to Crisp Tours in anyway. Keep all receipts when making insurance claims.

Foreign exchange: We offer the lowest price possible for the features included with this tour. Compared to other European tours and it can't be beat. The major risk factor in pricing your trip is the **exchange rate of the Euro to the US Dollar.** In the unlikely event the Euro increases higher than what we predicted; we could show a loss. Currently, the dollar to the Euro is reasonable. We may not be able to tolerate an increase above 1.20 to the dollar. We cannot be expected to take a loss and pay for your vacation. In the unlikely event, the dollar falls below 1.20 to the Euro, for every .01 increase above 1.20 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.27 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase surcharge of \$175 per person. (.07 increase or 7x25=175 or \$175 per person.) To lock in your tour price, you may wish to **prepay your trip early.** This will enable us to exchange your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the US dollar. Refunds are the same as stated above even when making early payments.

Not included: Entrance fees to optional attractions not listed in brochure, ground transportation due to missed flights or when doing own air, flight upgrades, personal items, telephone calls, trip insurance, laundry, gratuities, beverages, lunches, two dinners, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

Responsibility: We have made arrangements with airlines, hotels and other independent suppliers to provide you with the services you purchased. We have taken all reasonable steps to ensure that proper arrangements have been made for your vacation. However, we do not accept any liability for the actions or omissions of independent suppliers, over whom we have no direct control. We cannot control such factors as weather, government travel restrictions, mechanical breakdowns, your physical, medical or mental disabilities, your failure to obtain proper travel documents or your failure to follow travel instructions. Every effort will be made to provide you with the service and places of interest we have described. All prices, descriptions, activity scheduling and places of interest are subject to change without notice if we feel it would be beneficial to the group. If services included in this tour cannot be provided, or there are changes to the itinerary for reasons beyond our control, we will make every effort arrange other provisions of comparable services.

Airline Tickets: We will be purchasing airline tickets after **November 1, 2025** once your second payment is received. We will notify you immediately after booking your airline tickets via e-mail. We ask you to verify your itinerary and confirm that your names match your passport. These airline e-tickets are your tickets. They are non-refundable and nontransferable, however, if cancelled, a voucher may be obtained for future travel one year from the date of issue. After booking, no changes can be made after 24 hours without a penalty.

Tour Extensions: If you wish to depart before or return later than the scheduled tour, or you choose to purchase the land package only, you must let us know prior to November **1**, **2025.** In most cases, we can make optional arrangements at little or no extra cost to you.

Land Package Only: If you wish to make your own air arrangements, subtract \$1,000 per person. We ask that you send us a copy of your airline travel itinerary. You will then be responsible to meet our bus at the Munich Airport in the morning on Sep 16, 2026 or at the hotel. If you are unable to meet the busses because of your schedule or a missed connection, we may be able to arrange private shuttle transportation to and from the hotel at your expense. He calls from beginner through advanced as well as contras and old fashion barn dances.
