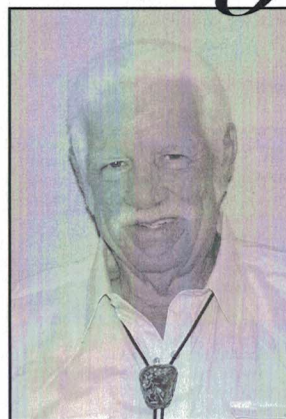

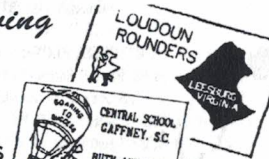

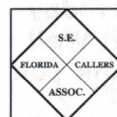

EDITOR'S DESK



Many articles have been written about Square Dancing. Some about it's health benefit. Some about it's sociability aspect. Some about its ability to improve recall. Some about how it helps students improve in school. All of these are true. All pertain to Square Dancing. Question: How many of you got into Square Dancing because of one of these things? How many began Square Dancing because it was fun? Square Dancing has long been viewed as a sociable, FUN activity. Emphasis on fun. There are some callers who teach classes like a drill sergeant. Constant drilling over and over each call until it becomes "rote". This can create a problem later because the dancer does not realize

the importance of fun. Also, should the dancer go to another caller he may hear the same call from an unfamiliar position. Then when the dancers realizes they made a mistake, they are afraid or uncomfortable and may not realize they can (and should) just laugh about the error and keep on dancing. Square Dancing is a recreation. There are many forms of recreation in today's society. Some passive like television or computers, others active like bowling. In order to compete successfully we have to make Square Dancing fun.

I often relate different programs to jogging. There is a casual jogger who might run a mile, or even train and run a five Kilometer race. Not to win, but just for fun. I relate this to Mainstream, a fun level that should be welcoming to all dancers. On the other end of the spectrum we have the marathon and ultra marathon runners. These runners seldom smile, concentrate on training and timing and pacing. This is our Challenge dancers. There are many levels in between each spectrum. This depends on how much time and effort is involved. When you see some advanced and challenge dancers not smiling, remember they are having a lot of fun in there own way. I imagine there can be many other comparisons, as a former marathoner this is what I use. As a caller and dancer I do both because I enjoy the activity. I always do my best to make sure those around are having fun.

Speaking of fun, I hope to see many of you at Callerlab, and All of you in Atlanta for our National Convention.

President's Message

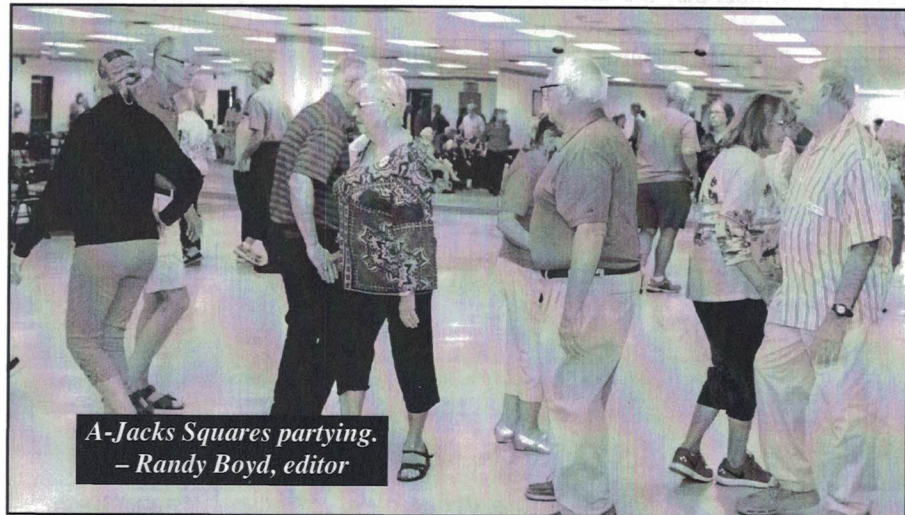
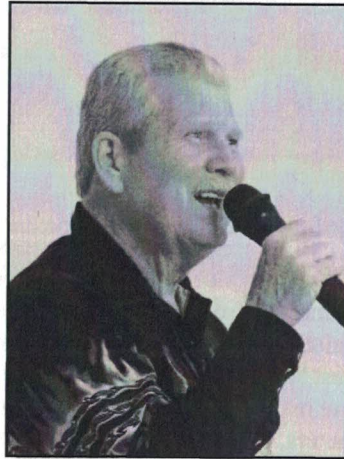

Franklin Delano Roosevelt (FDR) built the Little White House in Warm Springs, Georgia, in 1932, prior to being inaugurated as United States President in 1933. He frequently came to Warm Springs to swim in the buoyant 88° warm spring waters to help reduce the effects of polio that had struck him in 1921.

During FDR's presidency he developed many New Deal Programs (such as the Rural Electrification Administration) based upon his experiences in this small town.

FDR passed away at the Little White House in 1945 while posing for a portrait.

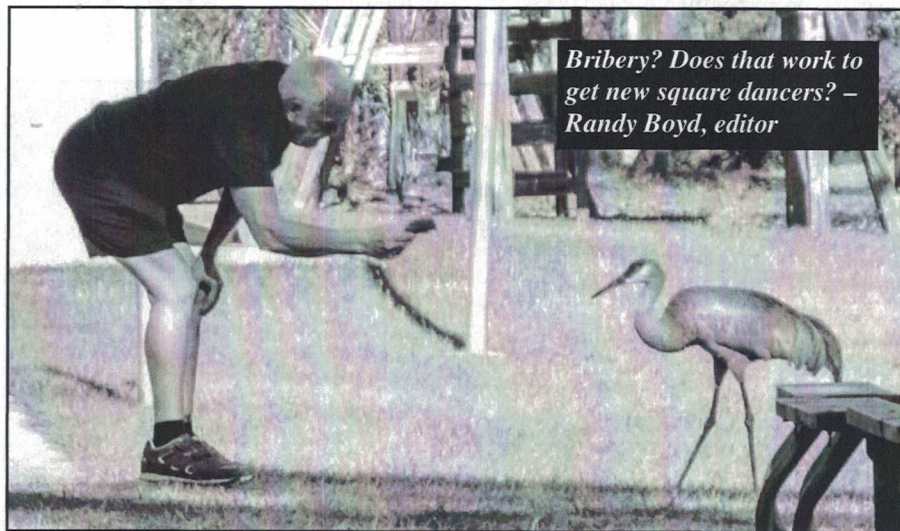
Our tour route will explore Atlanta's famous Peachtree Street from the suburbs to the city. Indians cut the first trails; Settlers drove their livestock down those trails. Then came the railroads, the war and two armies – one staggering and the other victorious. That was 1864. As we follow that same Peachtree Street today, you will see the sights and sounds of the high-tech city of tomorrow. From Civil War sites to Atlanta's first Victorian subdivision to old favorites like the Fox Theater and the Capitol, we will tell you the stories of how this tiny little railroad terminal grew to be an international city.

Atlanta, like Scarlett, is always in a hurry, reaching for tomorrow, but we

weren't always so big and beautiful. Lest you forget how far we have come, we will take you to the Atlanta History Center for an unforgettable look at Scarlett's town during that long-ago Civil War Battle of Atlanta, July 22, 1864.

We will visit the birthplace of Scarlett O'Hara with a tour of the Margaret Mitchell House. Ms. Mitchell painted a picture of the old South in her book and movie, *Gone with the Wind*, which still brings people to Atlanta searching for Tara. This is the apartment where she lived with her husband, John, when she wrote most of the book, garnering her the Pulitzer Prize, and the movie, which received a record 10 Academy Awards. It all started right here on Peachtree Street in a tiny little apartment dubbed "The Dump" by a tiny little woman named Margaret Mitchell Upshaw Marsh. Atlanta always just called her Peggy!

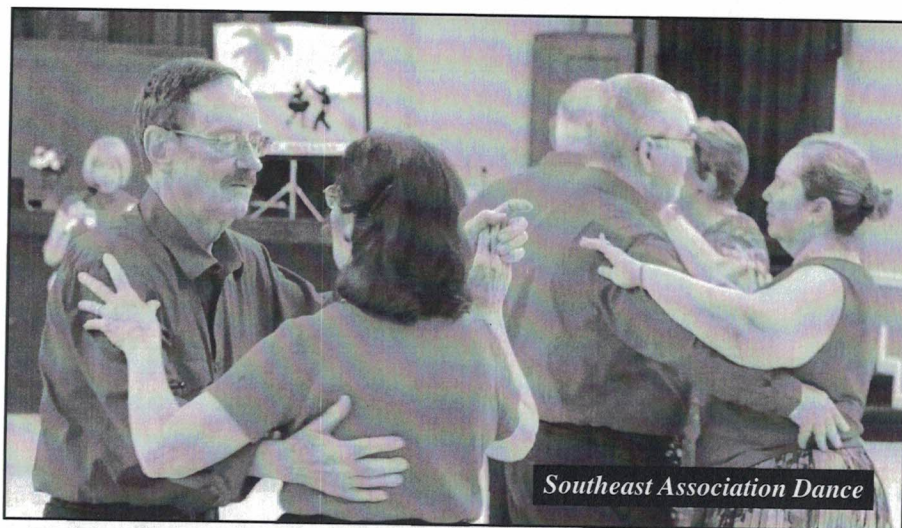

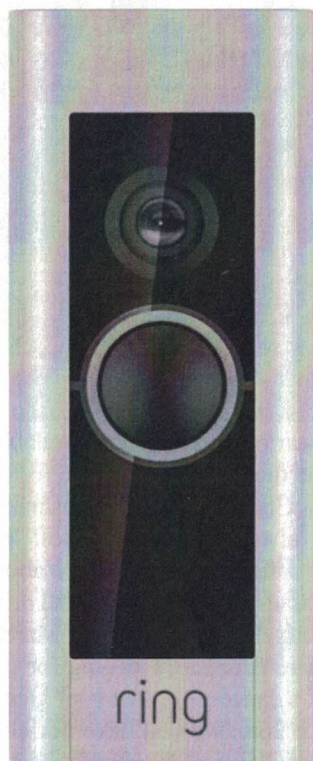
BUTTONS & BOWS

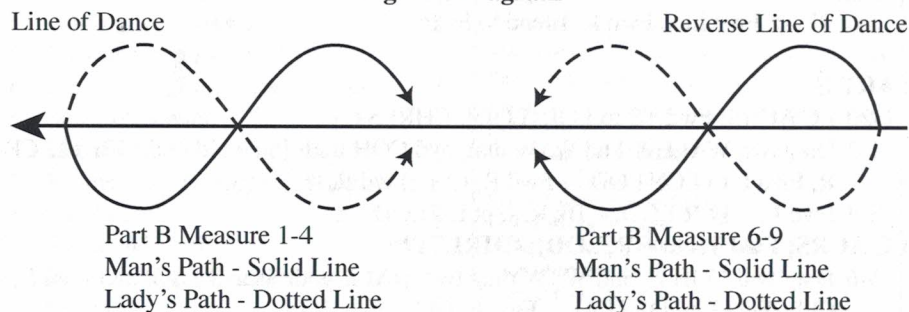
