




At the Convention, the dancers had a lot of fun. Keeping with my continuing theme, Square Dancing is a recreation. I saw dancers smiling and moving with the music.

This message is short because of the limited time for preparation (as the magazine was all prepared except for this and my editorial).



There are only two cities in the world that have two Nobel Peace Prizes on display within a few miles of each other. One is Johannesburg, South Africa. The other is Atlanta, Georgia!

The preacher's name was Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and he grew up in the city when the city was segregated and there were schools he could not attend, parks where he could not play, and restaurants where he was not welcome. He was a man of peace and he took up the banner and led the marches and the marchers for non-violent social change. He won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964. At the age of thirty-five, he was the youngest man to have received this honor. His life was taken in the tragic days of the Civil Rights Struggle in 1968. His dream is alive and well.

Our first destination today is the King Historic District on Atlanta's famous Sweet Auburn Avenue. Here you will see Ebenezer Baptist Church where Dr. King preached his first and last sermon. See the home where he grew up. Visit Freedom Hall for a personal look at the man, his family, and his heroes. Spend some time in the Civil Rights Museum as we remember the struggle and stand before Dr. King's tomb and read the familiar

words, "Free at last, free at last, thank God Almighty I am free at last."

Lunch is on your own at Atlanta's iconic Varsity Restaurant.


The President is known far and wide as Jimmy Carter. He

grew up in the red clay peanut fields of South Georgia, son of a successful farmer and land holder. His best friend was the child of a black tenant farmer who lived on the Carter farm. The boys, one black and one white, were not allowed to go to the same school or sit together in the local movie theater. President Carter didn't like it as a child and wouldn't tolerate it as an adult. The passion that brought him the 2002 Nobel Peace Prize was born back in the red clay fields of Plains, Georgia.

President Carter's Library and Museum rest quietly on a rise known as Copen Hill overlooking the city of Atlanta. In 1864, General Sherman sat astride his horse on this same hill as the Battle of Atlanta swirled around him – changing the face of Atlanta and the south forever. It is a fitting location for the library and museum of this soft-spoken son of the south who has risen from a bitter reelection defeat to become respected and loved throughout the world as an international negotiator of world peace and a better life.





HANDICAPABLE PROGRAM


This information was developed by the Handicapable Committee of the United Square Dancers of America, Inc. with the assistance of the CALLERLAB Handicapable committee and will provide information on a part of the Handicapable Program supported by USDA.

Remember, this activity is primarily for the residents. If you wan to have fun with the volunteers, perhaps a line dance just for them. Or, get a few extra wheelchairs, put the chauffeurs in the chairs and call one tip that way. But they have to maneuver the chairs on their own.



Generally Nursing Centers, Personal Care Homes and Assisted Living Communities are limited to dancing space and assistance. So, keep the calls very basic for the chauffeurs and have fun with variety of set up formations.

Involve the staff, volunteers, friends and families to partake in this activity. Wheelchair square dancing works very well as an intergenerational program. Enjoy programs that promote many different aspects of life. This activity is an exercise, a sing along, and a reminiscing program all rolled up into one event.

SOME WHEELCHAIR FIGURES

Heads Square Thru Swing Thru Ferris Wheel, Pass thru Boys Run Promenade (Short) Take Corner

Wear a glove on your left hand for two reasons. The direction right and left are too difficult for some dancers. So directions are given as gloved and bare. We also find the gloves help reduce the spread of colds in a group.

Try not to put to many turning movements together. It can cause the dancer dizziness and motion sickness. Squares can get big because of the room a wheelchair takes to maneuver. When doing a wheelchair dance, allow 20 by 20 area per square.

Wheelchair Square Dancing has an additional challenge in that you are not touching anyone. This means the dancers have to keep track in their mind where they are in a square in relation to other dancers.

HELPFUL HINTS

- 1. It's very helpful if the wheelchairs have foot rests.
- 2. Make sure the breaks to the chairs are not locked down.
- 3. Too much spinning of the chairs can make residents dizzy.
- 4. Gerry beds are a very different to handle than wheelchairs.
- Sometimes, residents have afghans on their laps. Be careful, they do not get tangled in the chairs.

Some residents really enjoy WATCHING the square dance, but do not want to participate. Please respect their wishes.

- 6. The chauffeurs should not be other E. Insurance Contact USDA Insurresidents.
- 7. The execution time of the calls is longer than normal.
- 8. Extra staff needs to be on standby in case of emergencies.
- 9. Motorized scooters work well with a square of all scooters.
- 10. If you are the chauffeur, introduce yourself to the resident in the chair before standing behind and maneuvering them.






