

Dancing is for Everyone

If you can walk, you can dance. The activities of Round, Contra/Traditional and Square (RCT&S) dancing welcome all ages and ethnicities.

Community dance groups can be found all over the world.

Anyone with the desire to dance simply needs a little motivation to move and to find fellow dancers. Square Dancing has become so

popular and well-liked that 33 U.S. states have designated it their Official State Dance. Whether you are interested in Square, Round, or Contra/Traditional dancing, local dance groups are waiting for you to join the fun.

Dance Your Way to a Better Life

All forms of physical activity are good for the mind, body and soul, and dancing is no exception. Doing so on a regular basis contributes to the following:

- **Cardiovascular Fitness** – Dancing – Round, Contra/Traditional and Square (RCT&S) – is a safe way to exercise. The moves are interesting, and the level of exertion is up to each participant. “Rev up” for a high-intensity workout, or take it slow and easy for a relaxing, yet beneficial, workout. Dancing regularly can lead to a slower heart rate, lower blood pressure and an improved cholesterol profile.
- **Healthy Environment** – RCT&S clubs are smoke- and alcohol-free. This allows the participants to dance and socialize in a safe environment.
- **Body and Brain Boost** – RCT&S dancers react to directions which are given, forcing the body and brain to be tightly coordinated. A number of moves are memorized, which helps keep the mind sharp.
- **Calories Burned** – Dancing burns between 200 and 400 calories in thirty minutes – that’s the equivalent of walking, swimming or riding a bike.
- **Steps** – The President’s Council on Physical Fitness and Sports recommends 10,000 steps per day to maintain physical fitness. Dancing, on average, provides over 3,000 steps per hour.

- **Sturdy Bones** – The side-to-side movement of dancing strengthens weight-bearing bones in the hips and legs, which helps prevent and slow the loss of bone mass.

- **Rehabilitation** – RCT&S is a great way to get back into the swing of things if you are recovering from an injury. Dancing keeps your joints moving, and is a nice alternative to jogging, or other high-impact activities.



- **Social Aspects** – You never know who you’re going to meet on the dance floor. Some types of dance, such as Contra, require you to switch partners every dance, so it’s easy to make friends. Lifetime relationships are formed, and some even meet the loves of their lives. There are dancing groups for everybody – handicapped people, gays and lesbians, youth, singles and couples.

Round Dancing

A ballroom-type dance characterized by movements where all couples dance the same steps in time with the music.

Modern Square Dancing is where four couples form squares and dance as a team.

LIGHTHOUSES #42 & #45

Cape St. George Light, Cape San Blas Light, St. Joseph Point Light, St. Joseph Bay Light

#42 Cape St. George Lighthouse: This brick lighthouse stood for 153 years until it toppled into the Gulf of Mexico in 2005. Over the years it had to be erected three times.

1st in 1833: It was erected near the island's western tip where it marked the narrow entrance to Apalachicola Bay, it stood 65 feet high. However, because of the sharp bend in the coastline ships could not easily see if they were approaching from the eastern Gulf so appropriation money was issued to move and rebuild the lighthouse.

2nd in 1848: Materials from the old tower were used for the new tower. Although the foundation was of brick, a hurricane in 1850 weakened it and during the fourth burricane of the 1851 Atlantic Hurricane Season it toppled in August of that year.

3rd In 1852: It was rebuilt 250 yards further inland. often using salvaged bricks from the original sight. This light was under Confederate control during the Civil War.

In 1995 Hurricane Opal was so sever it caused the light to lean 10 degrees. The tower was righted in 2002 but then completely collapsed in October 2005. Island Volunteers saw to it to be rebuilt in the middle of St. George Island and it is now opened to the public.

#43 Cape San Blas Lighthouse: this is another situation where 4 lighthouses have been built over the course of several years.

1st in 1848: The Lighthouse was built on Shoals running out from the Cape for 4.5 miles which made it dangerous for all vessels nearing the coast as the light was not that tall and could not be seen well enough. The lighthouse collapsed during a gale in the autum of 1851.

2nd in 1856: Unfortunatly this light had been completed only a few months when it was destroyed by yet another sever storm, also in 1856.

3rd in 1858: This lighthouse sustained serious damage but not by storms but by Union troops that landed in 1862 during the Civil War. Repaires were made and the light was re-established in 1865. Beach erosion was of great concern for the stability of the lighthouse but no appropriations were made and soon storms again destroyed the lighthouse.

4th in 1885: this tower was a sletion tower of iron with a light said to "light up the entire horizon". However, by 1887 the beach ahd started to



take ts toll but congress decided the present site could not be saved and wanted the lighthouse moved inland so it was rebuilt on near by Black's Island in early the 1900's. It is still in operation.

#44 St. Joseph point Lighthouse and #45 St. Joseph Bay Light-house: These 2 lighthouses pretty much co-existed in the 1830's. the town of St. Joseph was founded in 1836. Also in 1836 the Legislative Council of the Territory of Florida petitioned Congress for a lighthouse to mark the entrence to St. Joseph Bay, it was approved but was built on St. Joseph Point becoming operational 1839. It was a white conical brick tower 55 foot tall. The town of St. Joseph boomed and in 1838 hosted its Constition Convention to lay the ground work for Florida to become a state. However, in 1841 a ship brought yellow fever into the community. Within a matter of weeks, the town of St. Joseph was almost deserted. Two years later a hurricane with a hugh tital wave managed to destroy the city. The city did not survive to see Florida become the 27th State in 1845. The lighthouse did remain in service until 1847 when the light was extinguished and relite at Cape San Blas, For over 50 years, St. Joseph was known as the "City of the Dead", but people started to return to the area around the turn of the 19th century. Eventually the city of Port Joe was established just a few miles from the original site of St. Joseph.

In 1955 the old dwelling was sold to a private citizen who made it into a hay farm for cattle. Again, the home was sold to it's present owner who moved it about 20 miles to it's new home site on St. Joseph Bay. it is a private residence now, no visitors permitted, and is refered to as the "traveling lighthouse."


