From the ACA President By Bill Chestnut

Square dancing in Florida through the years

Once again, I have missed my deadline, causing Editor in Chief Stephen to hunt me down. I like sharing my ideas with both of my readers and this month gives me another chance. I am not a member of Callerlab, but I follow what they do. There is no reason for the American Callers Assoc. to battle about the definitions etc. Let's just get along.

The Callerlab Convention just wrapped up and the members present approved "The Proposal". It seems that it had to be passed in order for the work to begin on exactly how the new lists, levels and programs will work. September 2026 date was set for implementation. I shall follow along to find out how it affects you the dancer, and me the caller. I personally wish more time had been spent on where to find new dancers and how to start new groups. Oh well. Stay tuned for more updates.

I look back and see how fortunate I have been in the calling business. I have been able to hear, see and call with many of the Legends of square dancing. I follow a few web pages and Facebook groups and hear those names come up regularly. One name that comes up often is Tim Mariner. Tim called at the Blue Grey Festival in Lake City a couple of times and did the Moose Promenaders Presidents dance for 5 or so years. Tim was a true entertainer as well as a fantastic caller and teacher. I enjoyed working with Tim and he left us way too early. I have a couple of his songs recorded and have been known to play them at the Moose. There are a few You Tube videos if you search. Well worth a listen.

It was mentioned to me recently that the level of dancing is not as high as it used to be. There are not as many Plus dances as in the past, and some of the dancers that try do not know all of the Plus calls. I think as callers, we need to make sure that our dancers know what level they are ready to dance, and we need to teach any of the calls they need to learn to be better at any level. It seems that since the Covid season, we have maybe rushed our dancers a bit more than we should. More workshops are coming for those that attend the dances I call, regardless of the level. I have fallen in love with left-handed stuff, especially recycle.

I was reading about one club, and I don't remember where, that has a half hour of intro to square dancing every dance. Some nights there are no new people, but most nights they can acquaint a non-dancer with our activity. Food for thought, especially with the start of new classes so far away, and us needing to recruit new dancers. But September is coming, so let's start working to build those new classes now. Making your guests, visitors and new graduates feel at home will help your numbers grow.

I love to listen to other callers and research the good stuff, and file away the bad. One call I hear fairly often is Follow Your Neighbor and Spread. There actually is not a call by that name. There is Follow Your Neighbor, and there is a call Spread, but they are two separate calls. With them used together so often, callers are somewhat force to say "Follow Your Neighbor – No Spread." Callers, look at your use of the call and add some variety if you always add spread. There are so many fun things to do from left hand waves so check it out.

It is not long until summertime, then the fall season starts. Then comes new classes, the FCA Fall Clinics and special dances around the state. Make your plans now.

Let me know if you have thoughts on anything in my articles. I want to learn from you.

Keep 'em square and in case you forgot, wash your hands.

FCA PRESIDENT MESSAGE FOR JUNE 2025 It's time to be thinking seriously about the Florida Round and Square Dance Convention coming in January. I know it seems like a long way off, but the time will pass quickly. Most importantly, if you wish to be on the calling program for the convention you must submit your caller's profile to the FCA caller chair before July 31. As in recent years, your profile can be completed on-line at the Florida Callers Association website. The web site address is "flcallersassoc.org". Log in to the members area and choose "convention profile". Then simply indicate when and what programs for which you would agree to be scheduled and at the bottom of the form click "register". We hope you will be available to call. The convention success depends on us callers being willing and available to call. Thanks for your consideration and I look forward to seeing your name on the convention calling schedule. As I suggested last month, we callers should make an extra effort to promote and provide square dancing this summer. Hosting "fun nights" and offering lessons would be a couple of ways we can help increase the numbers in our square dance hobby. While during the fall and winter months we provide square dance opportunities for our "snow-bird" friends we should make and take the opportunity to offer lessons to our Florida "full-time" friends. Dave Muller and I are doing that in our community. We're brain-storming publicity and promotion ideas to attract dancers and even more importantly brain-storming a lesson program that will keep the dancers coming back and finishing lessons. The future of our square dance activity is dependent on our efforts to attract and keep new and younger dancers. We are encouraged by the old adage that success often comes with nothing more than trying one more time. If, in the course of your summer, you strike upon a promotion or lesson system that works, please share it with all of us. We each need every good idea we can find to refill the ranks of our square dancers. We also need new callers and they will most likely come from our new dancers. Think about the callers who, for whatever reason, have gone from our activity in the recent years. Please use your knowledge and experience to encourage and help prospects who not only would like to dance, but might like to become a caller. You don't have to do it on your own. Our FCA membership is rich with experienced callers who can help teach prospects to become callers. I'm confident those experienced callers would be glad to help prospective callers. With electronic communication now so versatile, putting distant people together is a snap. We all ought to be looking for ways to use this technology to help prospective callers and enlist new dancers. Let's each make a special effort this summer.






anyone Irish would describe as truly craic.








We ended the month with a "Hoop"-La when we celebrated March Madness by donning our favorite team's attire and colors. No rivalries, just fun!




