back for THE BARN'S Seventh and the BARN DANCERS First Anniversary the fourth of April.

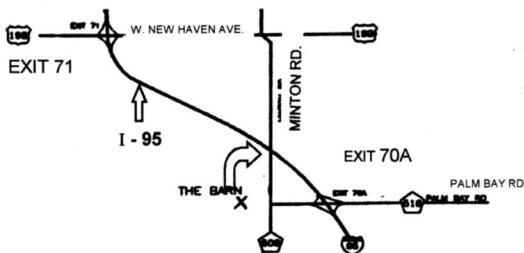

FROM THE BARN KITCHEN

TIRAMISU

2/3 cup Confectioners Sugar – 1 Cream Cheese – 8 oz.
2 ea. 8 oz. Whipped Topping – lite (split 1 & 1/2 - 1/2)

1/2 cup sugar – 1/4 cup water – 3 egg whites

1/2 cup hot water – 1 TB sugar
1 TB instant expresso coffee – 2 TB Kahlua

2 pkgs. Lady Fingers – 1/2 Tsp. unsweetened Cocoa

Combine Confectioners Sugar and Cream Cheese. Beat at high speed until well blended. Fold 1 & 1/2 of the Whipped Topping into cheese mixture.

Combine 1/2 cup sugar, 1/4 cup water, 3 egg whites in top of double boiler placed over simmering water. Beat at high speed until stiff peak forms.

Gently stir in 1/4 of egg whites into cheese mixture. Then fold in remaining egg white mixture. Set aside.

Combine hot water, expresso crystals, sugar and Kahlua. Stir well

Split lady fingers. Line bottom and sides of pan with open side in. Brush with coffee/Kahlua mixture. Spread half of cheese mix over lady fingers. Add another layer of lady fingers. Brush with remaining coffee Kahlua mixture. Pour remaining cheese mixture over. Top with remaining 1/2 of whipped topping. Sprinkle with cocoa.
