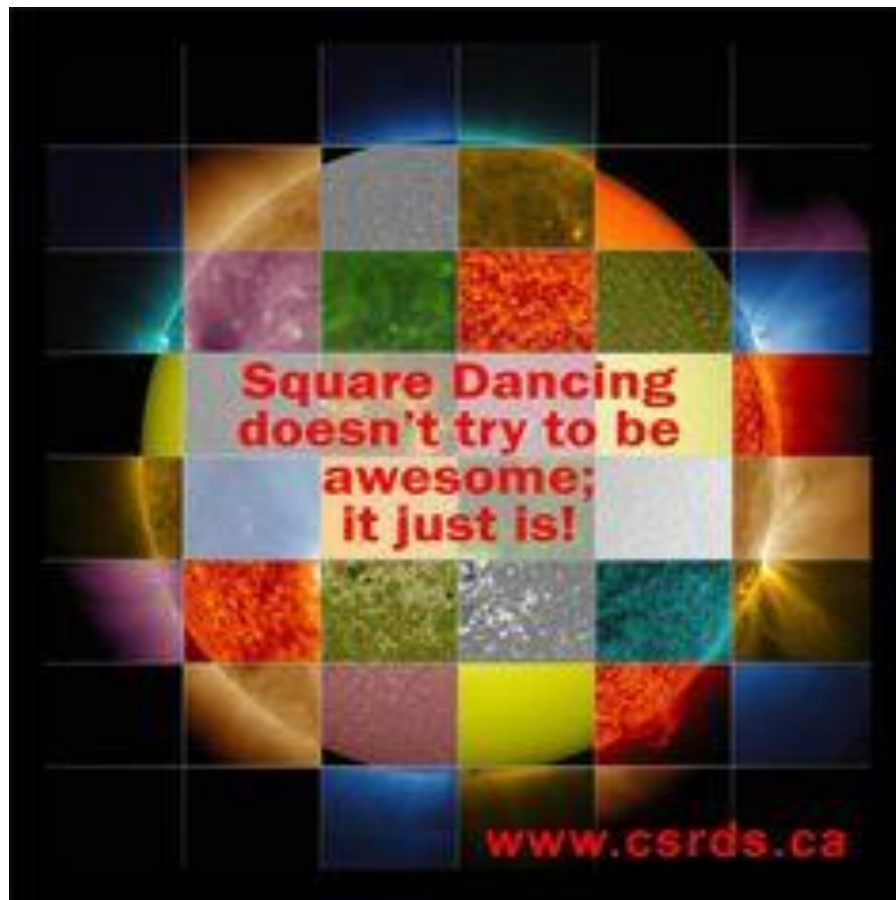

Greetings to the masses that enjoy my ramblings, and I understand it is a good solid 3 people. July 4 kicked off year 250 for our great country. I really enjoyed "A Capitol 4th" on PBS, and we stayed home and watched the fireworks on Channel 4 out of Jacksonville. No heat, no crowds, no mosquitoes, and the bang of the fireworks were only as loud as we wanted them. I hope you were all safe and happy for the Independence Day celebrations. I realize that our country is not perfect, but I think it is still the only place I want to live.

This summer we did not go to the national convention but I did get to see a lot of the videos from Waco. I enjoy hearing other callers and seeing how they use their music and the calls. Sometimes I "research" their material and add it in to my calling. I look for body flow, timing and things that most dancers can succeed at. I also find sequences I would never use. Callers, we need to provide the dancer the best experience we can. Watch the dancers and see if they flow from one move to another and from position to position without having to break a leg. John Saunders was a big believer that you give the dancers the correct amount of time to do the move and have them smoothly move around the floor. With the calls that have moved from A or the MS list to Plus, work on getting them to be a part of your choreography. Some work well; others will take a bunch of effort to get them incorporated. Let me know if I can help you.

The next major event for callers is the Florida Callers Association Annual Clinic, Dance and the annual meeting. The clinic takes place October 15, 16 and 17 at Southern Oaks RV Park in Summerfield. Thursday and Friday morning will be for newer callers and FCA members will be doing those sessions. Friday afternoon, eve and Saturday will be taught by Scott Bennett. Scott will also call a dance at the Village's Hacienda Center on Saturday evening and all are welcome. The FCA meeting will be held Sunday morning at Southern Oaks, followed by the convention programming meeting. The weekend wraps up Sunday evening back at the Hacienda Center for the Orange Blossom Squares 40th Anniversary Dance. The dance is also a fundraiser for the 2028 National in Daytona. Callers this is your opportunity to expand your skills so come join us. For dancers, you will enjoy both evenings of dancing and we hope to see you there.

We are finalizing the list of callers for next year's state convention, February 26 & 27, 2027. The Trail In dance will be Thursday, February 25 with Darrel Cevasco and me calling and Earle Collins on rounds. Come join us. Workshops have been added back to the daytime schedule and all of the fun things we can work in. The convention is at the Deltona Center again so please register and come join us. More information is available at the convention website, <https://www.dancergram.com/aa-FWS/convention/index.html>. Make your plans to attend and enjoy fun and fellowship set to music.

Be working on your class now and let's see the revival of our activity begin this year. Fellowship, light physical exercise and working the brain to some good music. What could be better?
