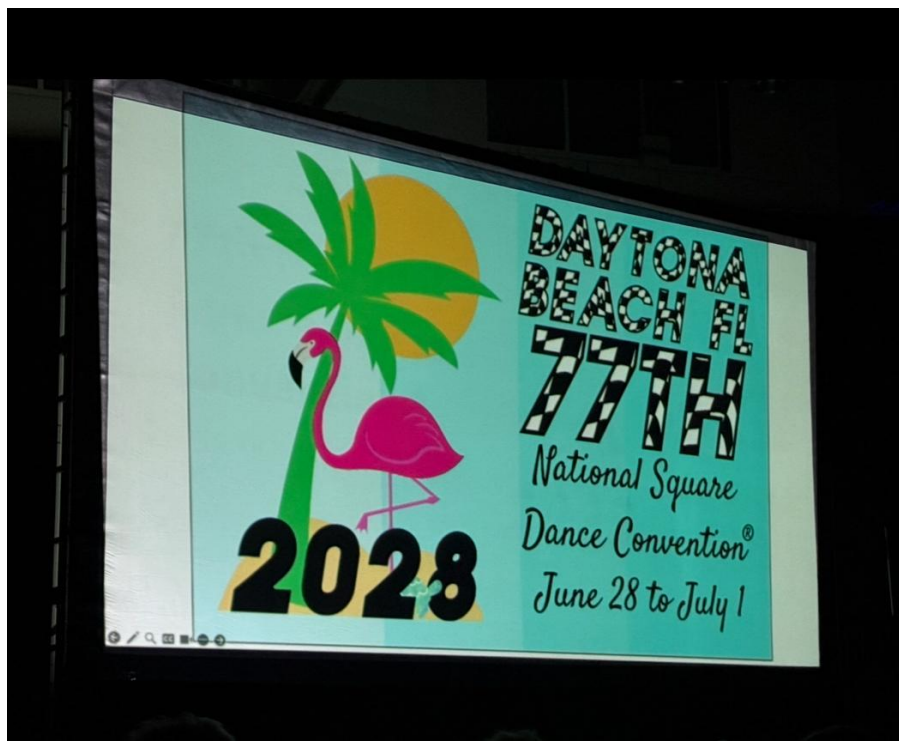

We had a great party in June. It was called Welcome Summer. Everybody wore their favorite summer outfits. There was lots of food and frolicking and much square and round dancing.

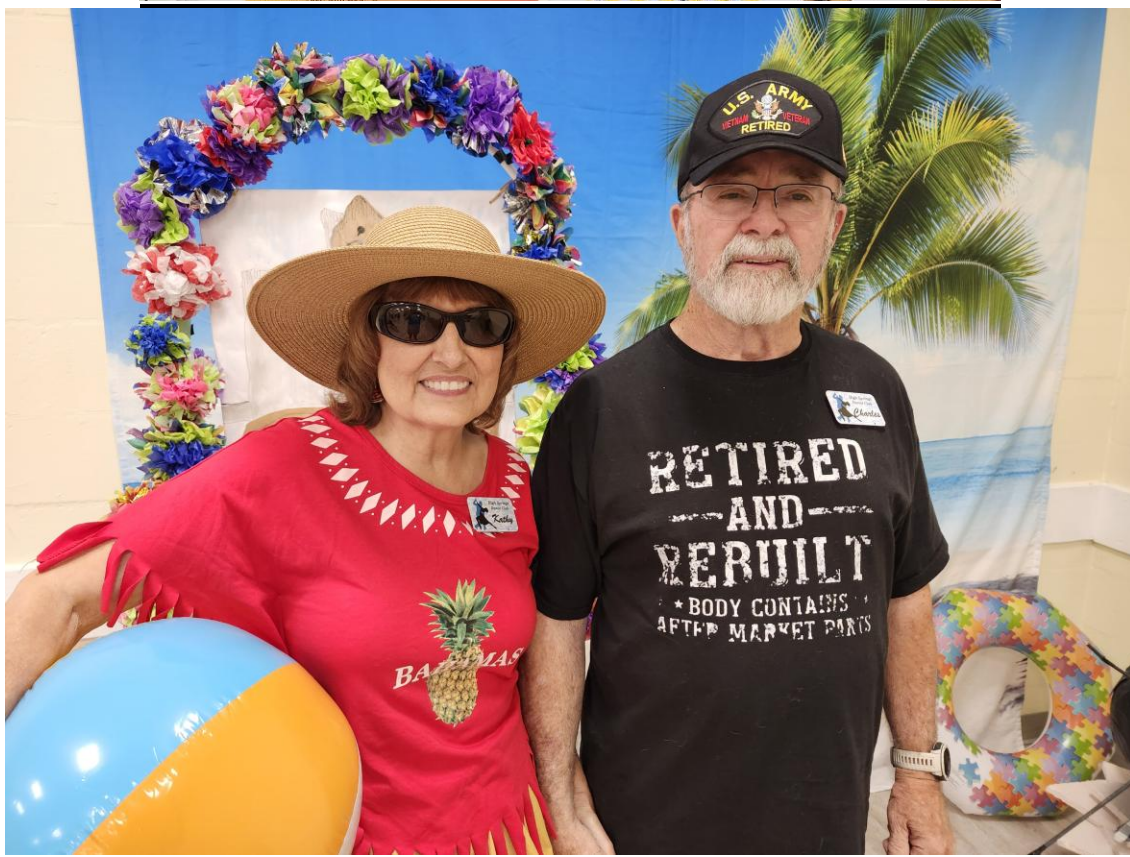
In July, we're hosting a UFO party! For each party, we always create a flyer, and it is posted on our

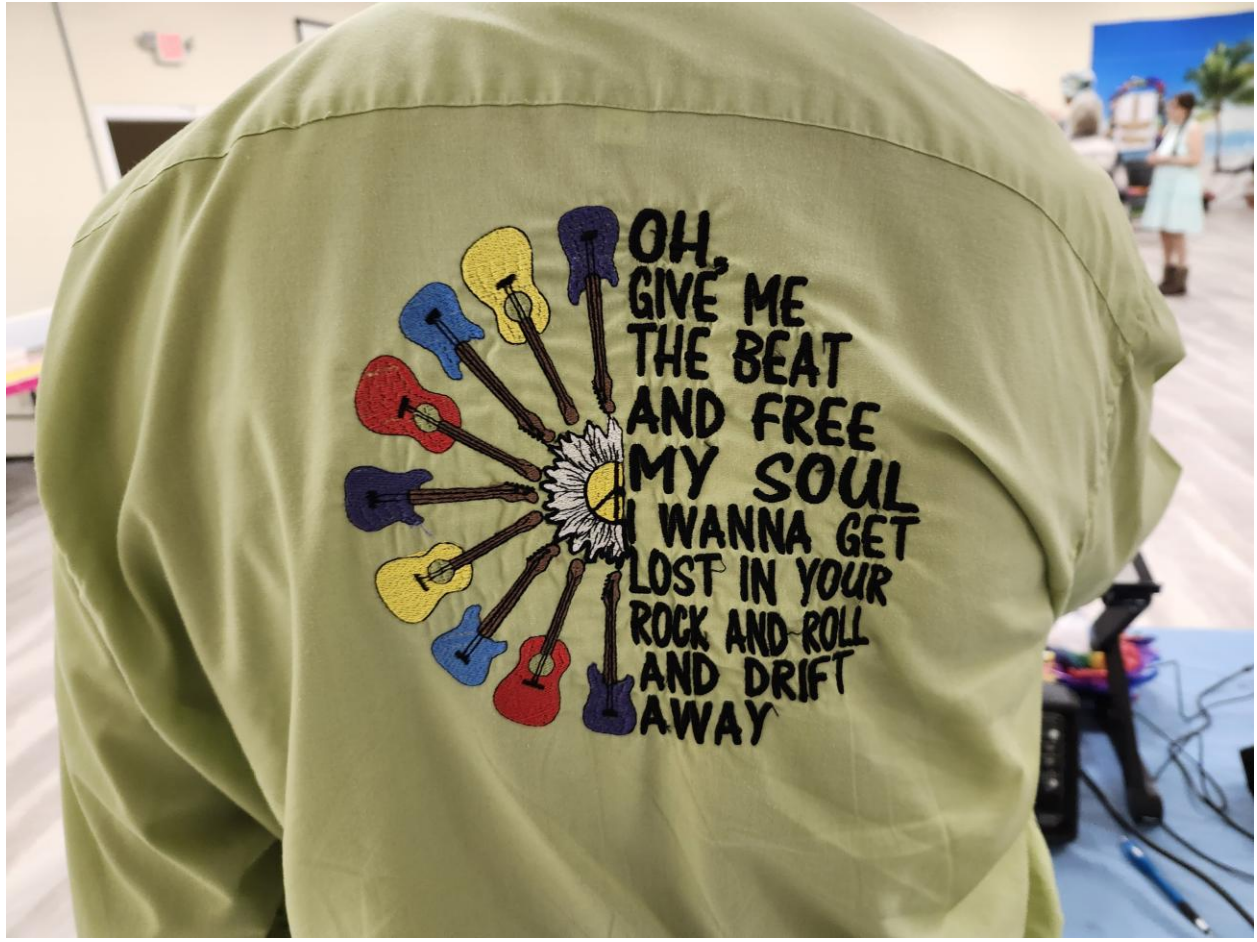

Brenda Cory, Ann Hadsall's daughter





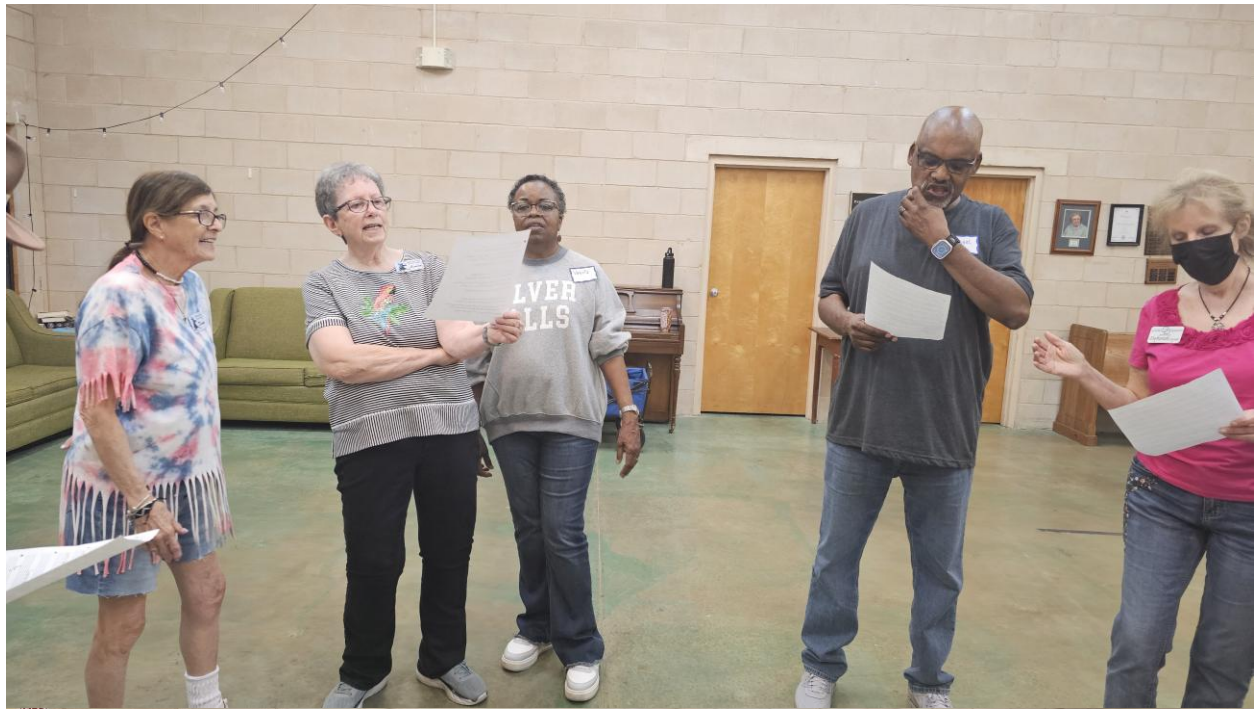

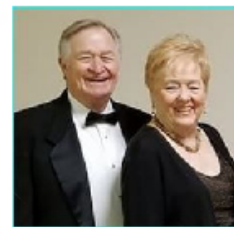


