



The new Mainstream and Plus programs that Callerlab has approved is beginning to take shape. Basically, it will be a mainstream program of 50 calls and 50 more on the Plus program. The lists have not been finalized so we don't know what will or will not be included for these programs, and full implementation does not happen until 2026. The more I hear, the more I feel it is a lot of to do over nothing. No matter what the calls are, square dancing is still the best activity you can belong to and we need all of us to go out and find new dancers. Most clubs start classes in September, so it is time to get busy. I spend a lot of time thinking about our activity and those people I have crossed trails with over the years. Some have gone on to the great beyond and some have just gotten out of dancing and calling. I heard from Jim Maroldo and Laura the other day. They moved off and I miss them. I also talk with Ernie Rollen often, but I miss seeing him and Frances. Ralph Beekman and Barbara no longer dance but were so integral with dancing in Lake City and Live Oak. 




