


We are still having a musician's jam session prior to the dance (5:00) and it seems we keep adding members on a regular basis. This has been a fun addition to our Tuesday nights.



Another Caller is retiring.

It has been a few years since an old friend of Mine lived in Jacksonville and called in this town. Marie and I even attended his wedding. I am talking about Jerry Reed and his lovely wife Del. He lived in Jacksonville for nearly ten years. He called for the Plus Fox, the Swingin Saints, and The MotivA2tors (an A2 club) in Jacksonville. In late 1993 they moved to Rockledge on the Central East Coast of Florida. Around 1996 he became the Assistant Executive Director of CALLERLAB, the International Association of Square Dance Callers. Then in 1999 he became the Executive Director. He served in this position for ten years until 2009.

When The Alliance of Round, Traditional, and Square - Dance (ARTS) was formed in 2002 to bring together the diverse groups making up the 'greater' American Folk Dance community, he took the position of Executive Director, a position he still holds. The ARTS provides effective public education of the square dance image and the health and fitness benefits of related dance activities to obtain corporate sponsorship, without diminishing any of the autonomy, or unique qualities and programs of any individual affiliate member.

Ramblings from beautiful downtown Melrose – by Bill Chesnut

I told it through the Grapevine: Ramblings from beautiful downtown Melrose. I have completed my stint as president of the American Callers Assoc. Past President is my favorite title. It was an honor to work with Mac Letson and all the ACA callers. ACA continues to work to make callers better, find new dancers and keep our activity fun.

Our friends at Callerlab, the other International callers' association are working on a new program to help recruit and retain dancers. Go to Callerlab.org and watch the video. It is interesting and has some good ideas in it. The one thing that we need is more people coming through the doors. Every club I know of could use a bunch more members. I still think the best way to get people in is to personally ask them. If you do ask, the most they can do is say no. But they might say yes. Invite a friend to join you. I am always trying to improve my teaching of the calls. It can be do si do for the new dancers or one of the A-2 moves for the advanced group. I have worked hard to eliminate boys and girls from the teaching unless it is a gender specific command. Star thru and Slide thru, the boys and girls have specific instructions, Most calls it is more about centers, ends, in lookers and out lookers. Read your definitions and try to figure out the best way to build a strong foundation for your dancers.

My call to play with lately has been stuff from a Thar Star. When you look at what that thar is, it is two waves and can be right or left-handed. At the advanced level we have calls for all 8 to do things, or all 4 couples. You can apply the same calls, just use them directionally. And remember the key word is Judgement. Use a little and have fun with it. Do not overdo it or make your dancers uncomfortable.

We had a great time at the Spin the Big Top Fundraiser in Port Orange in early May. Now we concentrate on the state convention itself, so plan to join us at the Florida State square and Round Dance convention in Deltona in January.

Callers, it is time to plan to go to the FCA Fall Clinic. This year the clinic is in the Villages again and Kip Garvey is the clinician. The dates are October 17 – 20. There is no cost for the clinic for FCA members. If you are not an FCA member the clinic costs \$50. (Or just join the FCA.) The dance Kip will call on Saturday night is open to all dancers, and you will be thoroughly entertained.

Now wash your hands, stay healthy and dance when you can. I look forward to seeing y'all.


