Our special events coordinator has informed us that on September 12 the themed party will be football.















went one step further and created a paper ballot for our voting purposes. As always, Mike demonstrated his creativity and enthusiasm for ensuring an entertaining dance.



Sawyer Gray, one of our younger members has been seriously ill and has been in and out of the hospital several times. Please keep he and his family in your prayers and thoughts.


