Northwest Florida Square & Round Dance Association (NWFSRDA) 2023 3rd Quarter Meeting – July 16, 2023, 3:00 PM Zoom Meeting Minutes

Call to Order & Welcome: Brian McDonald.

Invocation: Barbara McDonald.

Pledge: Alec Schmidt.

Roll Call: Quorum present. Quorum consists of 25% of Board of Delegates (Board of Delegates: Delegates from member area associations, member clubs, delegates-at-large, and the Executive Committee). Currently 14 / 25%= 4.

Minutes: April 15, 2023 minutes approved with minor edit.

Financial Reports: See 2nd Quarter Financial Report. Starting Checking Balance is \$9,955.66; Ending balance is \$10,302.26; savings are \$4,818.10. CD is \$4,023.44; this is funded by 4,000 from Savings as agreed, beginning April 17, 2023. We still have one club pending renewal – Seaside Squares - they will wait until next year to renew.

Roundup 2023: The venue has been paid; accommodations are arranged for the caller and cuer. Caller is using an RV park, reserved by Alec; \$58.00 per night. Lodging projected at \$500 for 3 others. Cottages are still available for groups of 8. So far 11 ads have been submitted for the program; ads are due by September 1. Asking folks to please pass out solicitations for "Happy" ads. Also, would like to have some Roundup Boosters if folks want to donate. Question is asked about dangles – should we have them? Maybe, if we can find a vendor in time. At this time, 6 registrations have been received. Ribbon promotion has started. Cottage rentals are still available at the venue – please let your club members know.

Roundup 2024: Caller Ted Kennedy and Cuer Sandy Sturgis are slated to call and cue for next year's Roundup; verbal commitments have been made. The Roundup will be held on October 25-26, 2024 in Pensacola at Ragon Hall.

Panhandle Press: No updates.

Florida Federation: See Barbara McDonald for Florida State Convention ribbons. There will be a dinner and fashion show. Trail-end dance will be January 18, 2024. The convention will be January 19-20, 2024. Watch for the \$500 Gift Card Raffle – tickets to come. See Barbara or the website for ad forms for the convention program, these are due by December 15. Still standing by for information on the flooring to be provided and who the convention chairperson will be.

Bylaws: all Bylaws and Standing Rules have completed and approved updates and have been sent out to delegates.

Old Business:

Nominating Committee: still need someone to be the chairperson, Diane DiBattista is suggested and will be asked. Informal poll is taken of current board for willingness to serve again next year — Laura/Secretary-yes; Alec/Treasurer-yes. The Roundup Chairperson for next year will be DeeCee Haslett so she will default to Vice-President. The McDonalds will not be serving again next year as President(s).

New Business:

Private Square Dance Halls: Discussion is held concerning the needs of privately-owned halls. Could NWFSRDA assist monetarily? The possibility for grants will be looked at.

Pattie Lewis 8-28-2023. She was a long time member of several clubs in NW.






